1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-5-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to  
 2 authorizing the Department of Health and Human Resources to promulgate a legislative  
 3 rule relating to procedures pertaining to the Dangerousness Assessment Advisory Board.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 5. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN  
 RESOURCES TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-5-1. Bureau of Public Health.**

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on March 8, 2022, authorized under the  
 2 authority of §27-6A-2 of this code, modified by the Department of Health and Human Resources to  
 3 meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State  
 4 Register on October 4, 2022, relating to the Department of Health and Human Resources  
 5 (procedures pertaining to the Dangerousness Assessment Advisory Board, [64 CSR 26](#)), is  
 6 authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Department of Health and Human Resources to promulgate a legislative rule relating to procedures pertaining to the Dangerousness Assessment Advisory Board.
