A BILL making a supplementary appropriation by adding a new item of appropriation and
increasing the expenditure of public moneys out of the Treasury from the balance of
moneys remaining as an unappropriated surplus balance in the State Fund, General
Revenue, to the Department of Economic Development, Office of the Secretary, fund
0256, fiscal year 2023, organization 0307, by supplementing and amending Chapter 11,
Acts of the Legislature, Regular Session, 2022, known as the budget bill for the fiscal year
ending June 30, 2023.

1 WHEREAS, The Governor submitted the Executive Budget Document to the Legislature 2 on January 11, 2023, containing a statement of the State Fund, General Revenue, setting forth 3 therein the cash balance as of July 1, 2022, and further included the estimate of revenue for the 4 fiscal year 2023, less net appropriation balances forwarded and regular and surplus 5 appropriations for the fiscal year 2023, and further included recommended expirations to the 6 the unappropriated surplus balance of State Fund General Revenue: and 7 WHEREAS, It appears from the Governor's Statement of the State Fund, General 8 Revenue, there now remains an unappropriated surplus balance in the Treasury which is available 9 for appropriation during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023; therefore

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That Chapter 11, Acts of the Legislature, Regular Session, 2022, known as the budget bill,
to fund 0256, fiscal year 2023, organization 0307 be supplemented and amended to read as
follows:

38 24 The above appropriation to Local Economic Development Partnerships (fund 0256,

39 25 appropriation 13300) shall be used by the Department of Economic Development for the

40 26 award of funding assistance to county and regional economic development corporations or 27

41 authorities participating in the Certified Development Community Program developed under 28

42 the provisions of W.Va. Code §5B-2-14. The Department of Economic Development shall

43 29 award the funding assistance through a matching grant program, based upon a formula

44 30 whereby funding assistance may not exceed \$30,000 per county served by an economic

45 31 development or redevelopment corporation or authority.

46 32 From the above appropriation for Directed Transfer – Surplus (fund 0256, appropriation 33

47 70099), \$105,000,000 shall be transferred to the Economic Development Project Fund (fund 34

48 9069) and \$10,000,000 shall be transferred to the Broadband Development Fund (fund 3034).

NOTE: The purpose of this supplemental appropriation bill is to add a new item of appropriation from the State Fund, General Revenue unappropriated surplus for the fiscal year 2023.
