Dear President Tomblin and Speaker Thompson:

Enclosed is a compilation of receipts and expenditures from the Stream Restoration Fund (SRF) for fiscal years 1999 through 2008, as required by WV Code §22-11-7a(2)(D). Each fiscal year has been itemized. The following is activity for fiscal year 2008:


- Expenditures - During fiscal year 2008 \$824,952 was deposited into the SRF and \$317,257 was expended from the fund. Expenditures consisted of \$235,972 for construction on the Dunloup Creek/Kilsyth Sewage Treatment Facility in Fayette County, \$2,694 for remediation of the Ohley Stream Bank Restoration Project in Kanawha County, \$247 for remediation in the Devil's Fork Watershed in Raleigh County, \$50,000 for construction at the Summerlee AMD Treatment Project in Fayette County, and \$28,344 for remediation projects in Clay, Grant, Harrison, Monongalia, Pocahontas, Preston, Randolph, Tucker and Upshur counties through the Stream Partners Sub-Grants program.
- Acres of Streams Reclaimed – The Dunloup Creek/Kilsyth Sewage Treatment Facility project will remove straight pipe sewage discharge and failing septic system discharge from 10,000 feet of Dunloup Creek. The Ohley Stream Bank Restoration Project stabilized 3,000 feet of Cabin Creek through the planting of trees. The Devils Fork Watershed project will remove straight pipes and provide sewage treatment to 50 homes in the headwaters of Devils Fork. Phase I of the Summerlee AMD Treatment project included the installation of check dams and an open limestone channel to raise the pH, reduce metals, and improve habitat conditions.

Promoting a healthy environment.

- Effectiveness of Stream Restoration – The Dunloup Creek/Kilsyth Sewage Treatment Facility project is currently under construction. The project, when complete, will capture sewage from 150 residences that were previously entering the stream. The Ohley Stream Bank Restoration Project will effectively reduce the amount of sediment introduced into Cabin Creek from bank erosion. The Devils Fork Watershed Project will be designed in 2009 and constructed in 2010. The Summerlee AMD Treatment Project water quality improvements cannot be documented until completion of Phase II, scheduled for 2009. Stream Partners Sub-grants are used to conduct outreach and education, water quality monitoring, and to construct water quality improvement projects.
