Enclosed is a compilation of receipts and expenditures from the Oil and Gas Reclamation Fund for Fiscal Year 2018, as required by WV Code 22-6-29(b).

During the fiscal year, \$78,500 was collected and deposited in the fund from permit fees and other revenues. Expenditures from the fund were \$70,541.62 which covered two emergency spills, one construction of a well cellar cover and Personal Services and Benefits for one employee.
