2017 PUBLIC LIBRARY FACILITY ASSESSMENT SURVEY

Overview

In April 2017, the West Virginia Legislature passed HB 2792 requiring the West Virginia Library Commission to formally survey the state's public libraries concerning: facility conditions and needs; technology capacity; collections; and public meeting spaces. The legislation further required the Library Commission to prepare a report of the findings and estimate the cost of a ten-year improvement plan.

The survey supports the conclusion of a similar, but not as extensive, 2013 review. Many of West Virginia's library facilities require major repairs and many others require extensive renovation or replacement. When considering the following report, it is important to remember that the 2017 survey asked librarians to self-assess building needs and conditions. Cost estimates for upgrades are probably low because of this self-assessment, attachment to current buildings, and lack of funding. Answers to questions concerning plans to renovate or replace existing facilities are from the perspective of library directors that are looking at the possibility of that happening, not the need for that to happen.

The Library Commission has no set standards for public library square footage. When advising on renovation and replacement projects, the Library Commission suggests a minimum of 5000 square feet for branch library facilities. Like many other states, the Library Commission uses: [Public Library Space Needs: A Planning Outline/2009](#) developed by Anders Dahlgren for the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction, Wisconsin's state library development agency, as a standard for determining library space needs. Ultimately however, all decisions on square footage are made by the local library. In developing cost estimates for new building construction for this report, the Library Commission used 5,000 square feet for branch facilities and looked at the needs of individual main libraries.

Population projections are a key element of facility planning. Using data compiled by the West Virginia University Bureau of Business and Economic Research, this includes projections for West Virginia counties through 2030.

Data on facility conditions, needs, and public meeting spaces was collected from September 11-30, 2017 using SurveyMonkey. The Library Commission put much thought into wording the questions and developing a condition assessment scheme. Before the survey was released, the Library Commission solicited input from Service Center library directors that resulted in several modifications. The goal was to obtain consistent assessment data in a manner that encouraged a high response rate. The response rate was 92% resulting in data on 159 of 172 public library facilities.

The assessment scheme used was based on that used by Brevard County Florida Public Schools. It required library directors to self-assess the general condition of the building and individual building systems identified in HB 2792. The following broad condition categories were used:

- **New** or like new condition. Replacement more than 10 years in future.
- **Good** condition. No issues or concerns. Consider replacement in 6-8 years.
- **Fair**. Average wear for building age; nearing end of useful life; will need replaced in 4-6 years.
- **Poor**. Worn from use; at end of expected life cycle; needs replaced within 1-2 years.
- **Critical**. Extremely worn or damaged; needs replaced immediately.

In addition to assessments, respondents were asked when the various building systems were last upgraded and given the following choices:

- 5 years or less
- 6-10 years
- 11-25 years
- 25 years or more
- Unknown

Comment boxes were provided for additional input and/or explanation. The survey also included questions on specific space needs and the status of any projects to remodel or replace facilities.

The Library Commission based facility cost estimates on **2017 Square Foot Costs with RSMeans Data** published by Gordian, a leading provider of facility and construction cost data. To develop a 10-year facility improvement plan, the Library Commission focused on buildings and systems identified as Critical, Poor, and Fair. Assessments of New and Good were not considered for upgrades or replacement within the 10-year period.

Respondents were asked a series of questions concerning compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). On all five questions approximately 15% of the respondents chose “Don’t Know” while another 15% responded no. The nature of these responses makes it difficult to calculate the cost of ADA specific renovations, so these were included in general renovation estimates.

Public Meeting Spaces

HB 2792 required data on the meeting space available for public use and the process for requesting its use. The Library Commission requested additional data in a series of questions concerning space needs, square footage of public meeting spaces, annual use of the spaces for non-library events, and meeting room policy. In identifying space needs, respondents were given a list of eleven items and asked to check as many as applied. The top three space needs identified by respondents were: indoor and outdoor programming space, storage space, and teen space.

Collections

Instead of duplicating effort by having library directors provide information on collections and technology capacity, the Library Commission used data already available from other reports. Collection data was extracted from FY 2017 Annual Bibliostat Reports completed by each library. This provided data for each of the 172 public library facilities.

Section 3 of the Bibliostat Report instructs librarians to report numbers of:

- Print Materials
- Audios – physical units
- Videos – downloadable units
- Print Serial subscriptions
- Electronic Books – not audio books
- Databases – Statewide
- Databases – Local/Other cooperative agreements
- Current electronic subscriptions

Electronic materials present a challenge because these are often obtained through a consortium. In addition, services such as Hoopla, Zinio, and Freegal make millions of songs, movies, TV shows, etc. available to library patrons. Some libraries include the total number of downloadable items available to patrons, some regard the services as a single database of multiple items, some report the number of items used. This report uses the numbers each library submitted.

Space needs calculations for public libraries include planning for expansion of the physical collection but the prevalence of more and more electronic materials affects those calculations. Since the common denominator of physical and electronic collections is cost, the Library Commission included data on the percentage of each library system's total operating expenditures that is spent on collections.

Technology Capacity

Technology capacity data was extracted from Library Commission State Library Network inventory. Libraries that have chosen not to be hosted on the State Library Network were asked to provide the same data for their sites. Data is provided on the number and age of staff and public access computers, current bandwidth, and availability of wireless, teleconference, and skype services. In the table below, cost per computer was calculated using the current state contract price plus basic software as priced by TechSoup. TechSoup is a nonprofit international network of non-governmental organizations that provides technical support and technological tools to other nonprofits, including public libraries.

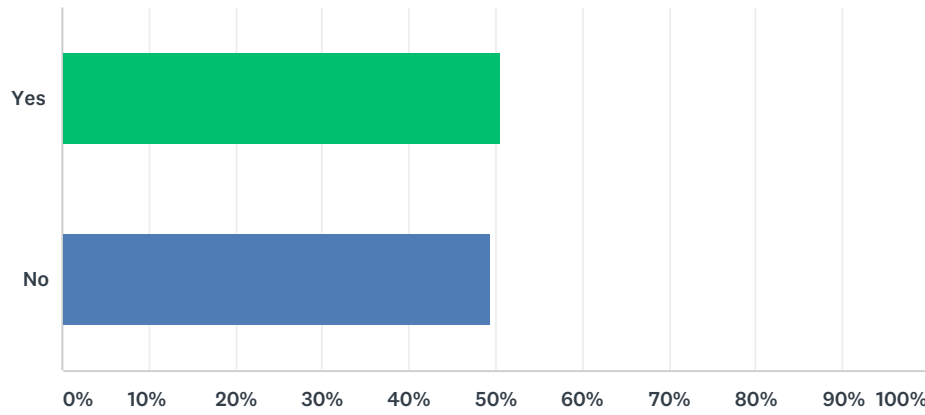

Q2 Is this a Branch Library?

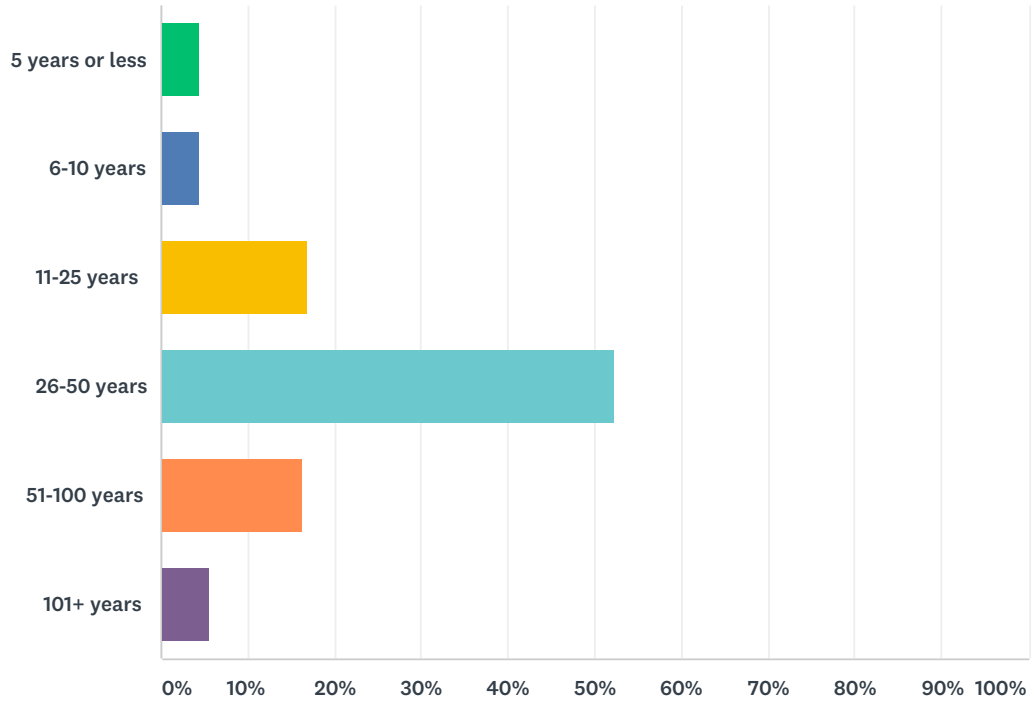

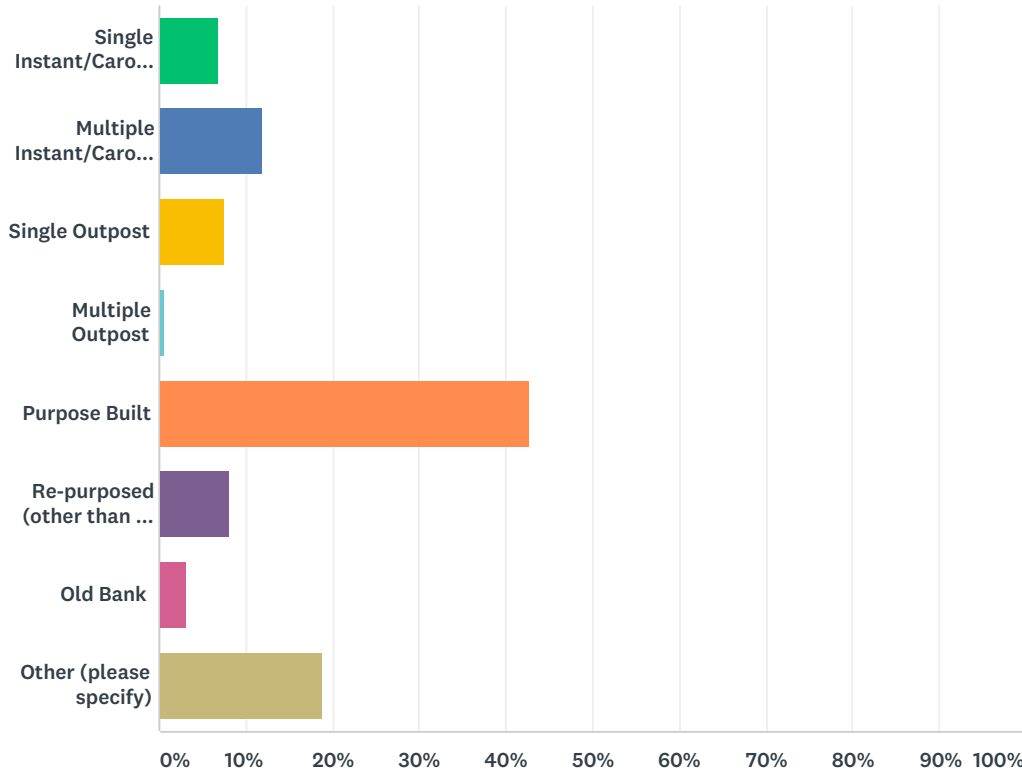

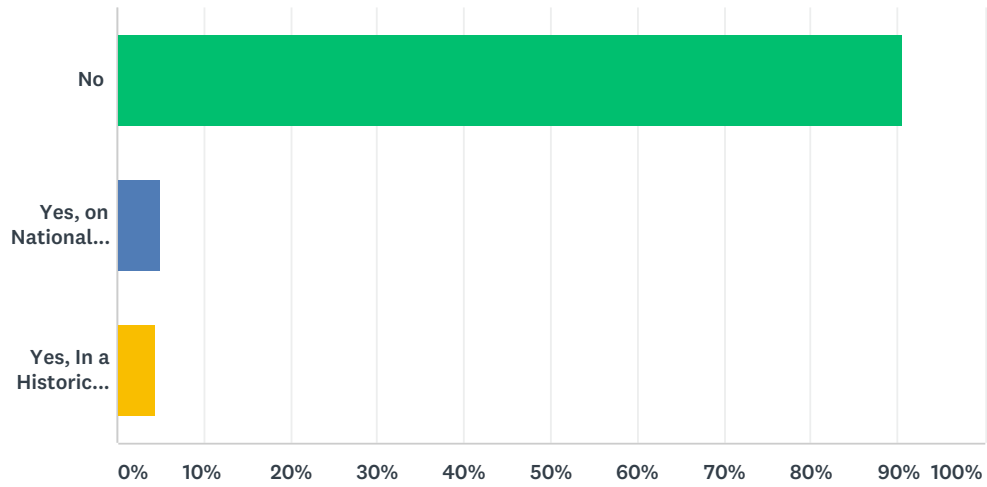

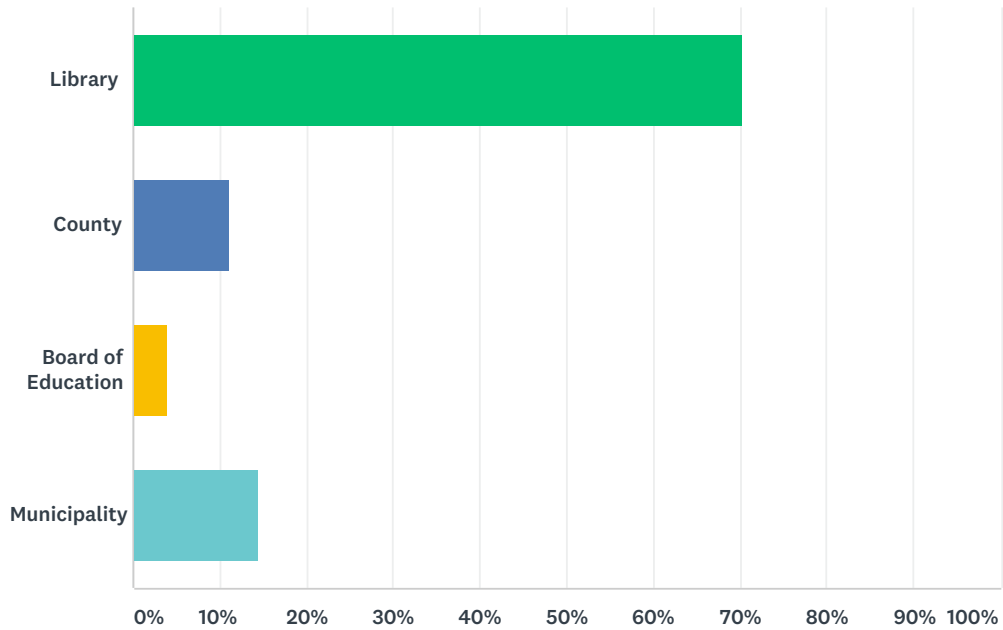

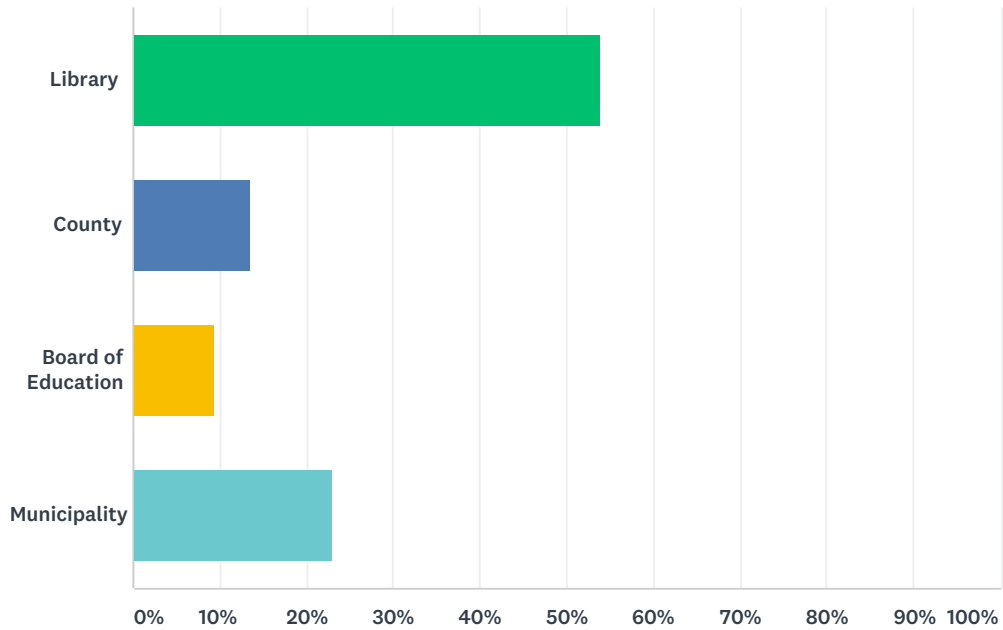

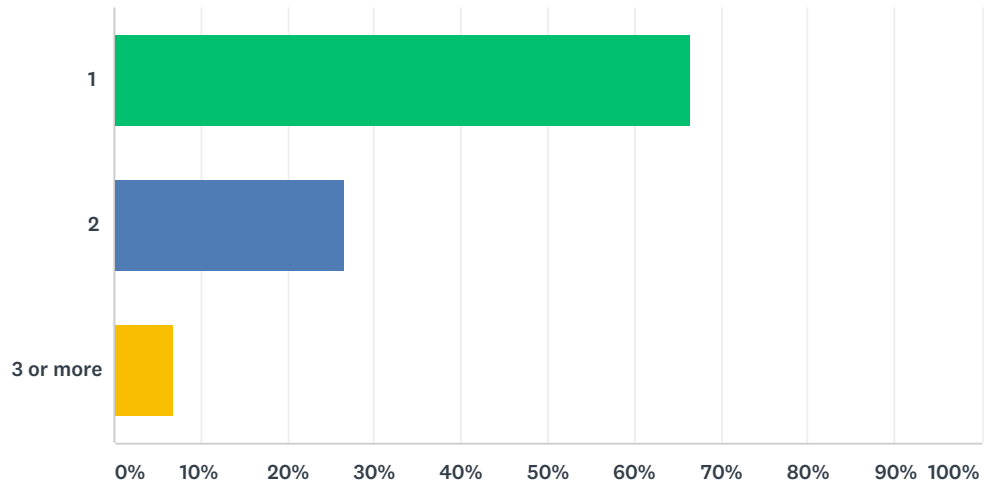

Q8 How many levels are in the building? Check one.

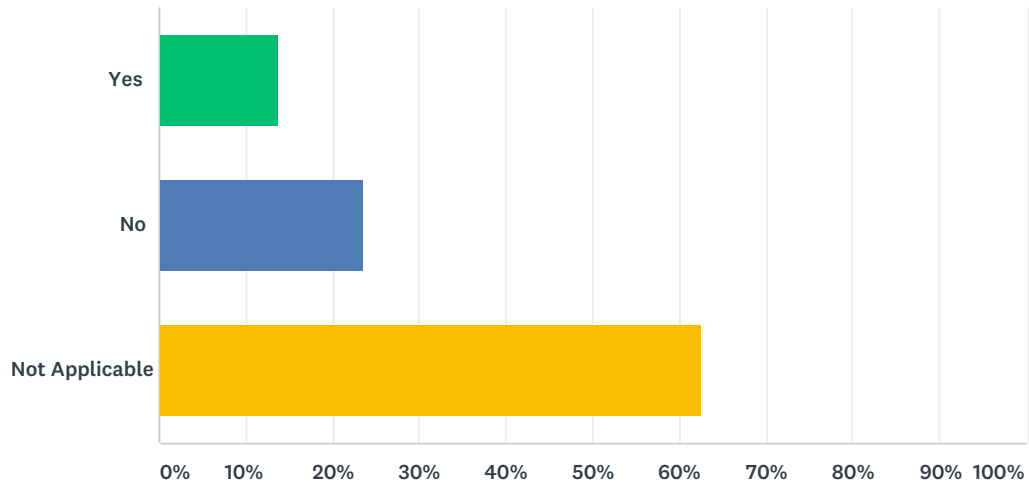

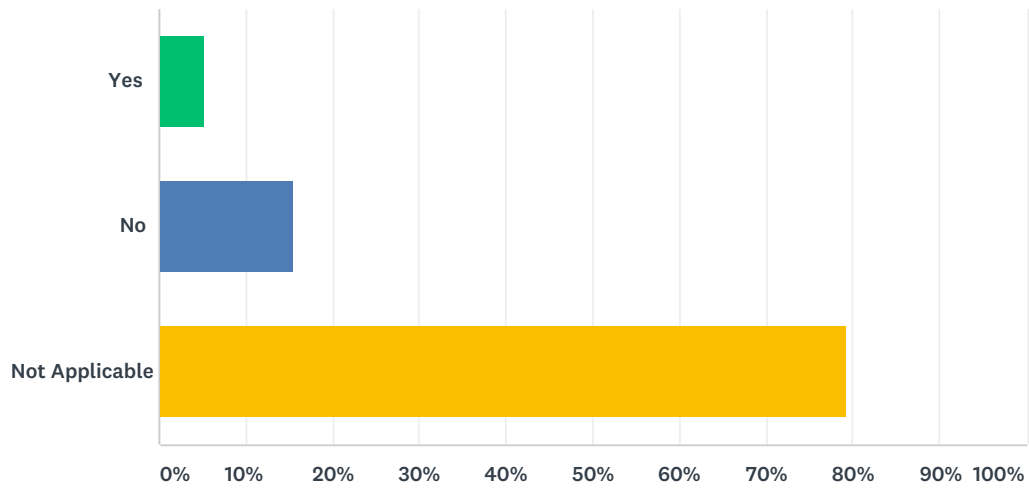

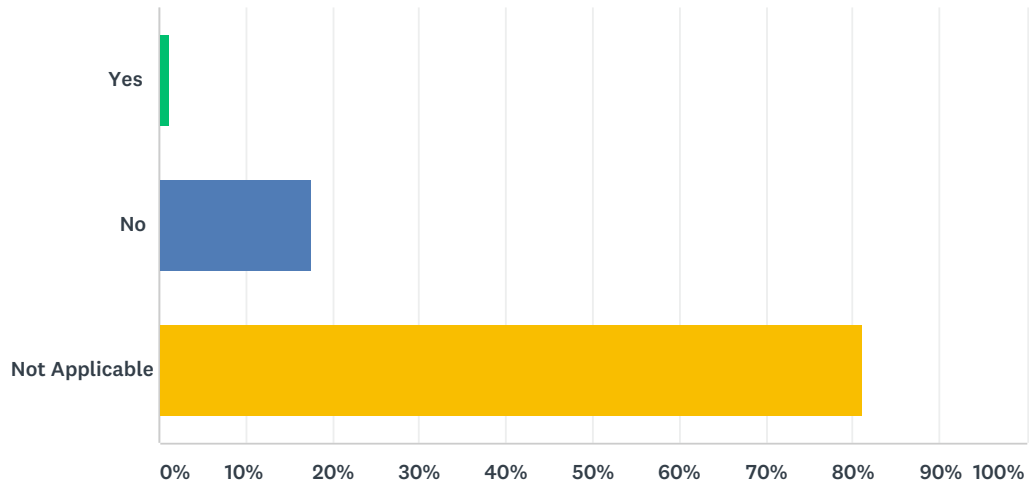

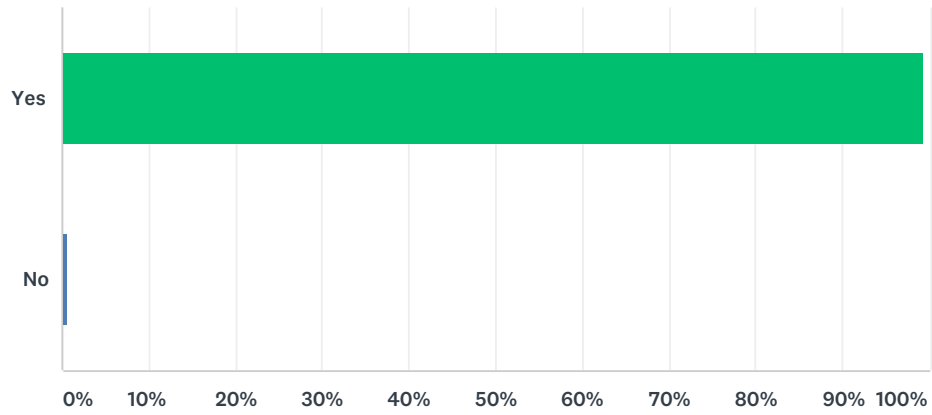

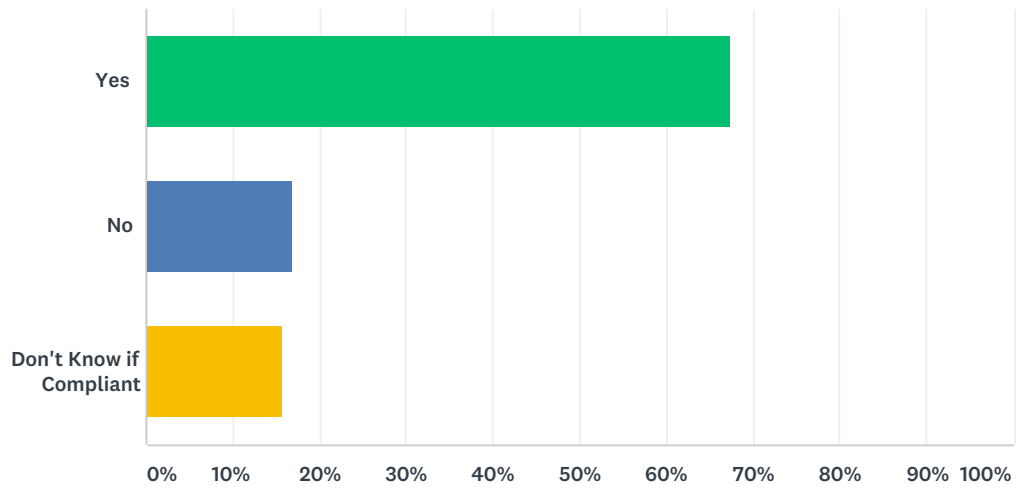

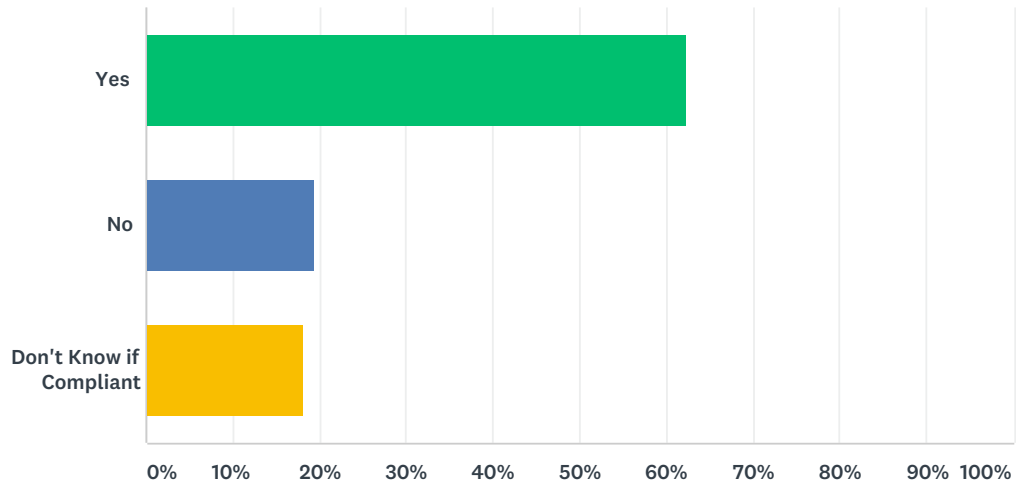

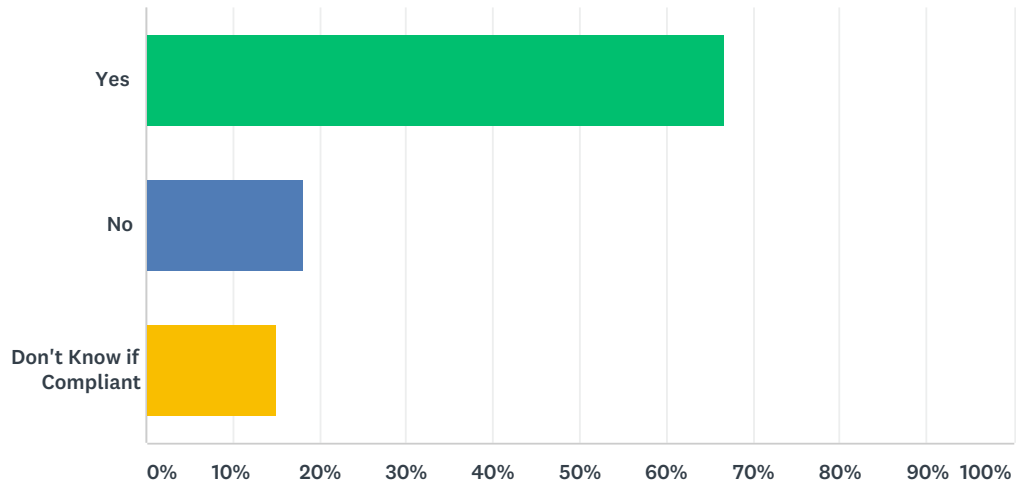

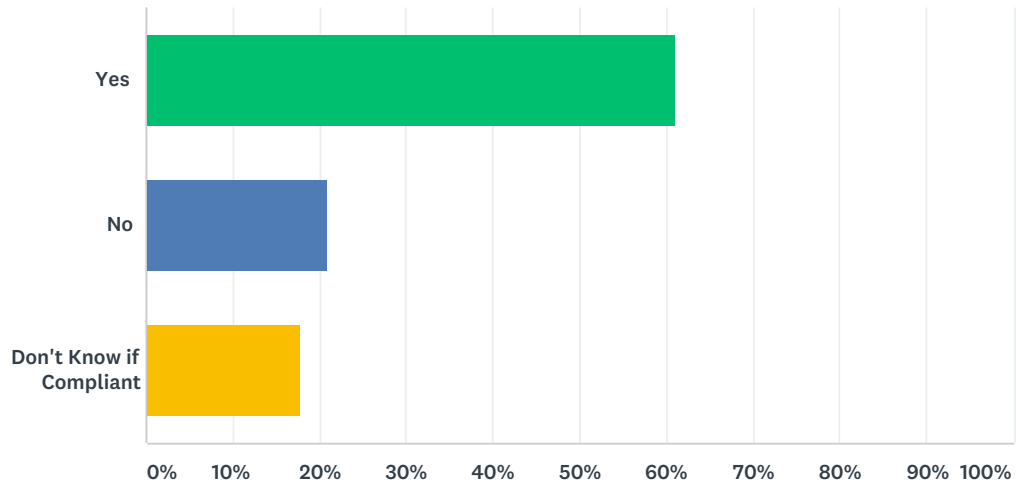

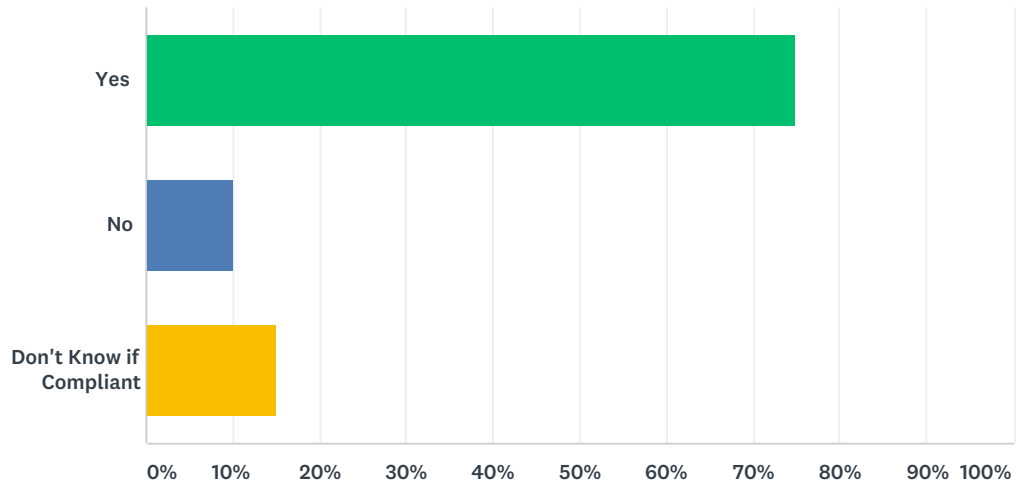

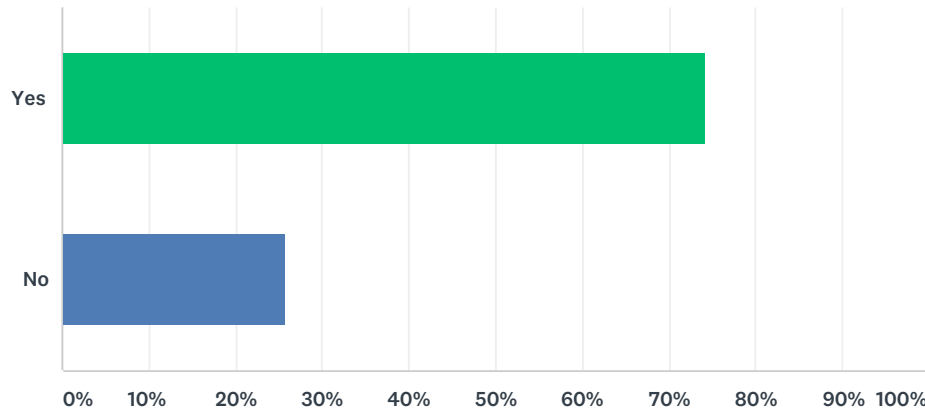

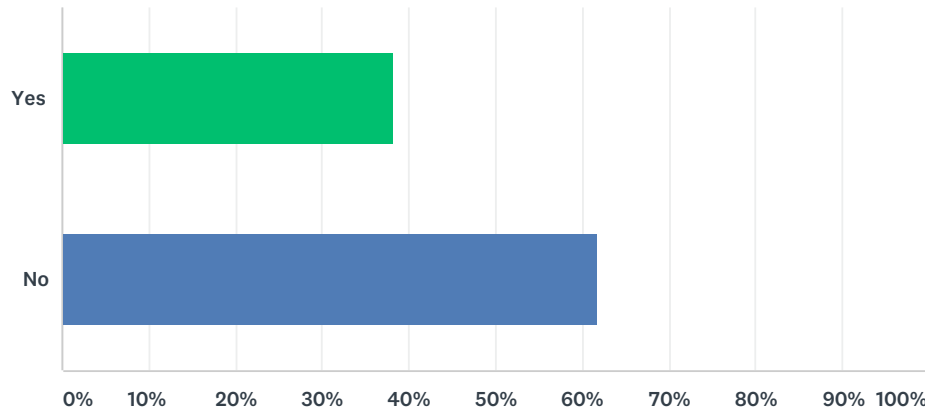

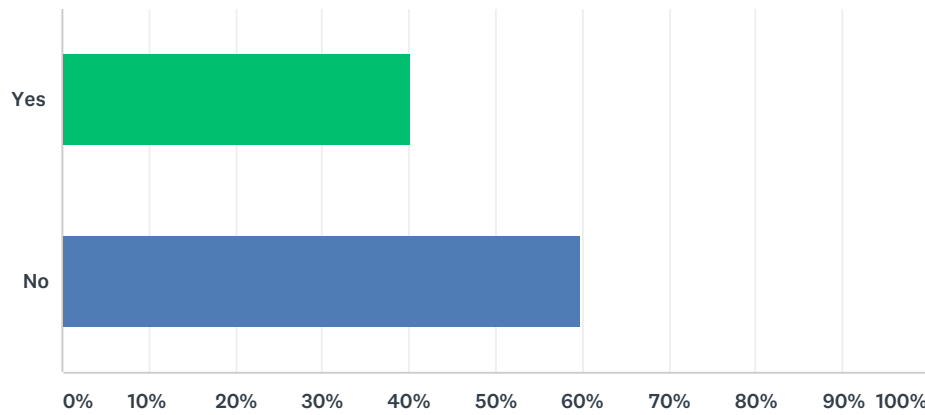

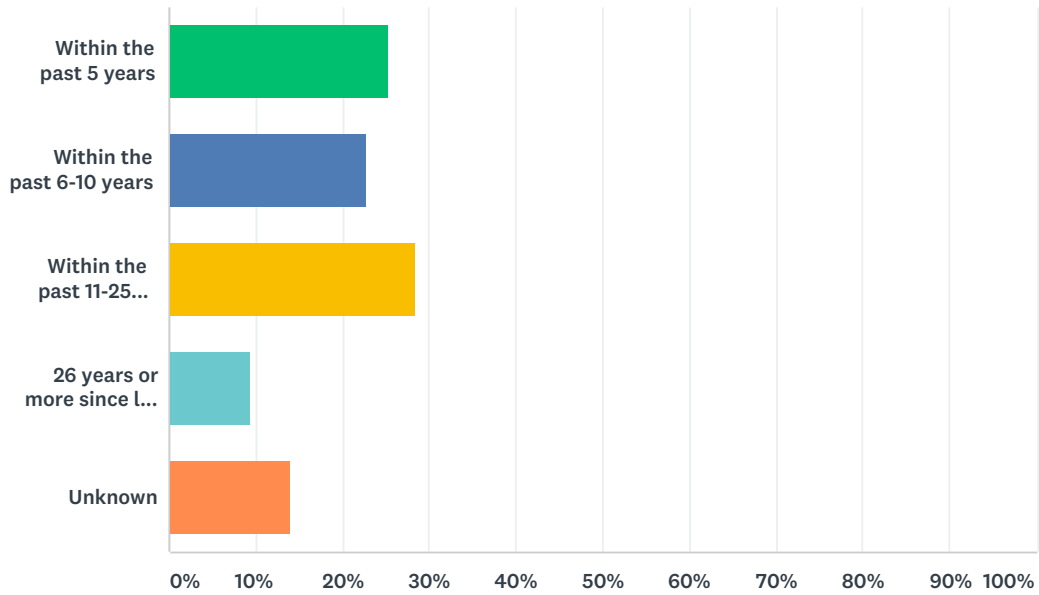

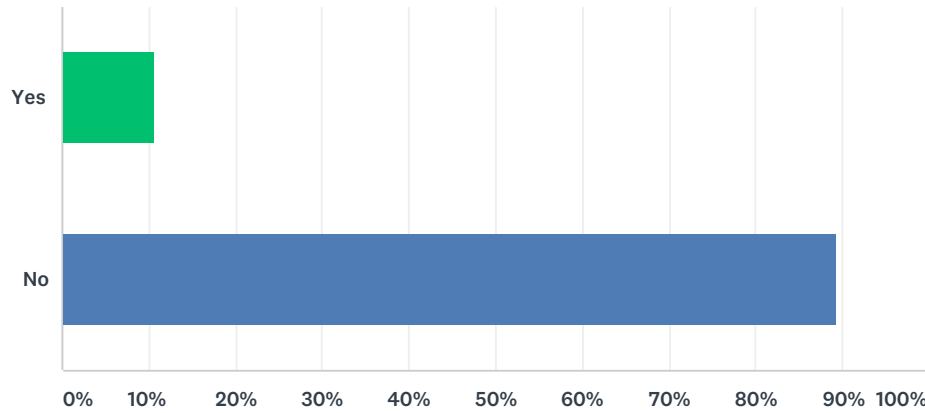

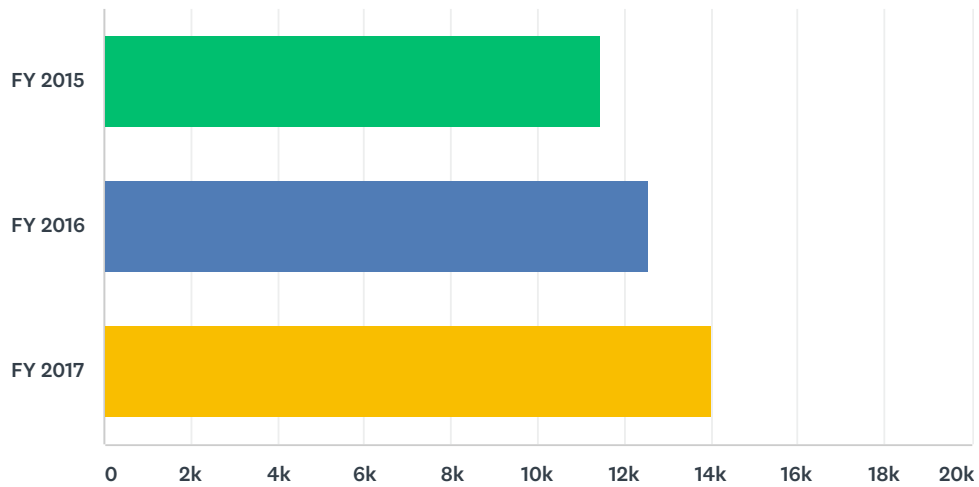

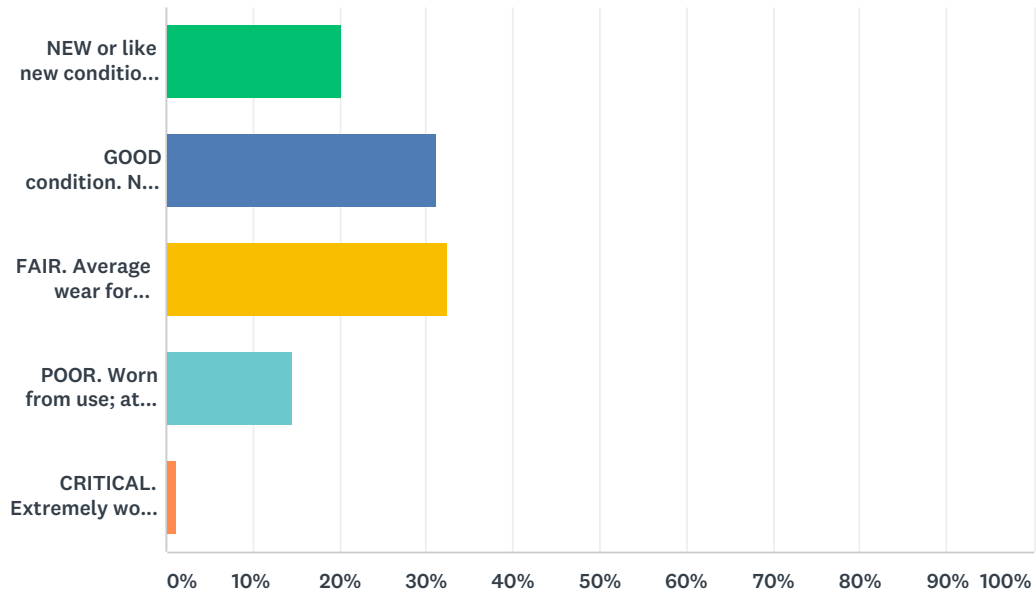
