AN ACT to repeal §28-5-26 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to escape of convicts and rewards.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

§1. Repeal of section relating to escape of convicts and rewards.

- 3 as amended, is hereby repealed.
