AN ACT finding and declaring certain claims against the state and its agencies to be moral obligations of the state and directing the auditor to issue warrants for the payment thereof.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

CLAIMS AGAINST THE STATE.

§1. Finding and declaring certain claims against the adjutant general; air quality board; alcohol beverage control administration; appraisers licensing board; attorney general; auditor's office; board of accountancy; board of embalmers and funeral directors; board of landscape architects; board of examiners for licensed practical nurses; board of optometry; board of pharmacy; board of physical therapy; board of professional engineers; board of psychologists; board of radiologic technologists; board of registered nurses; board of respiratory care; board of risk and insurance management; board of social work

 9 the state to pay each such claim in the amount specified
 10 below and directs the auditor to issue warrants for the
 11 payment thereof out of any fund appropriated and avail-
 12 able for the purpose.
