AN ACT to amend and reenact §30-31-15 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to continuing the West Virginia Board of Examiners in Counseling.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That §30-31-15 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted, to read as follows:

ARTICLE 31. LICENSED PROFESSIONAL COUNSELORS.

§30-31-15. Continuation of the West Virginia Board of Examiners in Counseling.

1 Pursuant to the provisions of article ten, chapter four of
2 this code, the West Virginia Board of Examiners in Coun-
3 seling shall continue to exist until the first day of July, two
4 thousand eight, unless sooner terminated, continued or
5 reestablished.
