AN ACT to amend and reenact §4-8-6 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to continuing the West Virginia Capitol Building Commission.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That §4-8-6 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 8. CAPITOL BUILDING COMMISSION.

§4-8-6. Continuation of the West Virginia Capitol Building Commission.

1 Pursuant to the provisions of article ten of this chapter,
2 the West Virginia Capitol Building Commission shall
3 continue to exist until the first day of July, two thousand
4 nine, unless sooner terminated, continued or reestablished.
