[Passed March 8, 2006; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section, designated §18-5-47, relating to requiring flood insurance on certain buildings, and the contents of those buildings, owned by a county board of education.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section, designated §18-5-47, to read as follows:

ARTICLE 5. COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION.

§18-5-47. County board flood insurance requirements.

- 1 (a) Each county board shall maintain flood insurance on
- 2 each insurable building that it owns and that meets one or
- 3 both of the following requirements:

4 (1) The building is within the identified special flood
5 hazard area which is the area on a flood hazard boundary
6 map or a flood insurance rate map that is identified as an
7 “A zone”, a numbered “A zone” or an “AE zone” or
8 regulatory one hundred year floodplain and the building
9 has a replacement value that is greater than three hundred
10 thousand dollars; or

11 (2) The building has been damaged in a previous flood
12 and flood insurance is required by the Federal Emergency
13 Management Agency.

14 (b) Each county board also shall maintain flood insur-
15 ance on the contents of each insurable building that it
16 owns and that meets one or both of the requirements set
17 forth in subsection (a) of this section.

18 (c) The buildings and the contents of those buildings
19 required to be insured by this section shall be insured at
20 the maximum amounts available through the National
21 Flood Insurance Program or the estimated replacement
22 value of the structure and contents, whichever is less.
