

AN ACT to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new article, designated §48-25A-1, §48-25A-2 and §48-25A-3, all relating to the creation of a Maternal Mortality Review Team; establishing its members and responsibilities; and giving the Bureau of Public Health rule-making authority for the team.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new article, designated §48-25A-1, §48-25A-2 and §48-25A-3, all to read as follows:

ARTICLE 25A. MATERNAL MORTALITY REVIEW TEAM.

§48-25A-1. Legislative findings.

- 1 The Legislature finds that there is a need for a process
- 2 to study the causes of maternal deaths. It has been
- 3 found that comprehensive studies indicate that
- 4 maternal mortalities are more extensive than first
- 5 appear on death certificates. The Legislature finds that
- 6 more extensive studies would enable a more fully
- 7 developed plan to avoid these deaths in the future.

§48-25A-2. Maternal Mortality Review Team.

- 1 (a) The Maternal Mortality Review Team is hereby
- 2 established under the office of Maternal Child and
- 3 Family Health. The Maternal Mortality Review Team
- 4 is a multidisciplinary team created to review the deaths
- 5 of women who die during pregnancy, at the time of
- 6 birth or within one year of the birth of a child.
- 7 (b) The Maternal Mortality Review Team is to consist
- 8 of the following members, appointed by the Governor:
- 9 (1) The Director of the office of Maternal Child and
- 10 Family Health, who is to serve as the chairperson of the
- 11 Maternal Mortality Review Team and is responsible for
- 12 calling and coordinating all meetings;
- 13 (2) The Commissioner of the Bureau for Public Health

- 14 or a designee;
- 15 (3) The Chief Medical Examiner in the Bureau of
- 16 Public Health or a designee;
- 17 (4) The Director of the Division of Vital Statistics or
- 18 a designee;
- 19 (5) Representation from each of the three medical
- 20 schools in the state;
- 21 (6) The Director of Obstetrics, the Director of the
- 22 Neonatal Intensive Care Unit and the Director of
- 23 Pediatrics at each of the tertiary care hospitals in the
- 24 state;
- 25 (7) One representative of the West Virginia State
- 26 Medical Association:
- 27 (8) One representative of the West Virginia Nurses
- 28 Association;
- 29 (9) One representative of the West Virginia Society of
- 30 Osteopathic Medicine;
- 31 (10) One representative of West Virginia Academy of
- 32 Family Physicians;
- 33 (11) One representative of the West Virginia Chapter
- 34 of the American College of Nurse Midwives;
- 35 (12) One representative of the West Virginia Chapter
- 36 of the American College of Obstetrics and Gynecology;
- 37 (13) One representative of the West Virginia Chapter

- 38 of the American Academy of Pediatrics;
- 39 (14) The Director of the Child Fatality Review Team;
- 40 and
- 41 (15) Any additional person that the chair of the team
- 42 determines is needed on a particular case being
- 43 considered.
- 44 (c) Each member shall serve for a term of five years.
- 45 Of the members of the commission first appointed, one
- 46 shall be appointed for a term ending the thirtieth day of
- 47 June, two thousand nine, and one each for terms ending
- one, two, three and four years thereafter.
- 49 (d) Members of the Maternal Mortality Review Team
- 50 shall, unless sooner removed, continue to serve until
- 51 their respective terms expire and until their successors
- 52 have been appointed and have qualified.
- 53 (e) An appointment of a physician, whether for a full
- 54 term or to fill a vacancy, is to be made by the Governor
- 55 from among three nominees selected by the West
- 56 Virginia State Medical Association or the organization
- 57 to be represented on the team. When an appointment is
- for a full term, the nomination is to be submitted to the
- 59 Governor not later than eight months prior to the date
- on which the appointment is to become effective. In the
- 61 case of an appointment to fill a vacancy, the
- 62 nominations are to be submitted to the Governor within
- 63 thirty days after the request for the nomination has
- 64 been made by the Governor to the chairperson or
- 65 president of the organization. When an association fails
- 66 to submit to the Governor nominations for the
- 67 appointment in accordance with the requirements of

- 68 this section, the Governor may make the appointment
- 69 without nominations.
- 70 (f) Each member of the Maternal Mortality Review
- 71 Team shall serve without additional compensation and
- 72 may not be reimbursed for any expenses incurred in the
- 73 discharge of his or her duties under the provisions of
- 74 this article.

§48–25A-3. Responsibilities of the Maternal Mortality Review Team.

- 1 (a) The Bureau of Public Health in consultation with
- the Maternal Mortality Review Team shall, pursuant to
- 3 the provisions of article three, chapter twenty-nine-a,
- 4 promulgate rules applicable to the following:
- 5 (1) The standard procedures for the establishment,
- 6 formation and conduct of the Maternal Mortality
- 7 Review Team; and
- 8 (2) The protocols for the review of maternal
- 9 mortalities.
- 10 (b) The Maternal Mortality Review Team shall:
- 11 (1) Review all deaths of women who die during
- 12 pregnancy, at the time of birth or within one year of the
- 13 birth of a child;
- 14 (2) Establish the trends, patterns and risk factors;
- 15 (3) Provide statistical analysis regarding the causes of
- 16 maternal fatalities in West Virginia; and

- 17 (4) Promote public awareness of the incidence and 18 causes of maternal fatalities, including 19 recommendations for their reduction.
- 20 (c) The Maternal Mortality Review Team shall submit 21 an annual report to the Governor and to the Legislature 22 concerning its activities and the incidents of maternal 23 fatalities within the state. The report is due annually 24 on the first day of December. The report is to include 25 statistics setting forth the number of maternal 26 fatalities, identifiable trends in maternal fatalities in 27 the state, including possible causes, if any, and 28 recommendations to reduce the number of preventable 29 maternal fatalities in the state. The report is to also 30 include the number of mothers whose deaths have been 31 determined to have been unexpected or unexplained.
- 32 (d) The Maternal Mortality Review Team, in the 33 exercise of its duties as defined in this section, may not:
- 34 (1) Call witnesses or take testimony from individuals 35 involved in the investigation of a maternal fatality;
- 36 (2) Contact a family member of the deceased mother, 37 except if a member of the team is involved in the 38 investigation of the death and must contact a family 39 member in the course of performing his or her duties 40 outside of the team; or
- 41 (3) Enforce any public health standard or criminal 42 law or otherwise participate in any legal proceeding, 43 except if a member of the team is involved in the 44 investigation of the death or resulting prosecution and 45 must participate in a legal proceeding in the course of 46 performing in his or her duties outside of the team.

- (e) Proceedings, records and opinions of the Maternal 47 48 Mortality Review Team are confidential, in accordance 49 with section one, article seven, chapter forty-nine of 50 this code, and are not subject to discovery, subpoena or introduction into evidence in any civil or criminal 51 **52** proceeding. Nothing in this subsection is to be construed to limit or restrict the right to discover or use 53 54 in any civil or criminal proceeding anything that is 55 available from another source and entirely independent of the proceedings of the Maternal Mortality Review 56 57 Team.
- 58 (f) Members of the Maternal Mortality Review Team 59 may not be questioned in any civil or criminal 60 proceeding regarding information presented in or 61 opinions formed as a result of a meeting of the team. 62 Nothing in this subsection may be construed to prevent 63 a member of the Maternal Mortality Review Team from testifying to information obtained independently of the 64 team or which is public information. 65
