

AN ACT to amend and reenact §17A-3-16 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended; and to amend and reenact §17A-10-3 of said code, all relating to registration fees for vehicles; allowing a registrant to register a Class G vehicle for a two-year period; requiring all registrations for at least one full year; and facilitating expiration date changes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That §17A-3-16 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted; and that §17A-10-3 of said code be amended and reenacted, all to read as follows:

ARTICLE 3. ORIGINAL AND RENEWAL OF REGISTRATION; ISSUANCE OF CERTIFICATES OF TITLE.

§17A-3-16. Expiration of registration and certificates of title.

- 1 (a) Every vehicle registration under this chapter and 2 every registration card and registration plate issued under 3 this chapter expires at midnight on the last day of the 4 month designated by the commissioner: *Provided*, That 5 the commissioner may extend the period during which the 6 registration plates may be used.
- 7 Certificates of title need not be renewed annually but 8 remain valid until canceled by the division for cause or 9 upon a transfer of any interest shown in the vehicle.
- 10 (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of this section or of 11 any provision of this chapter, the commissioner shall 12 adopt a staggered registration system whereby the regis13 tration of Class A motor vehicles is for a period of twelve 14 consecutive calendar months, the expiration dates of the 15 registrations to be staggered throughout the year: *Pro-*16 vided, That on or after July 1, 1997, the commissioner shall 17 also offer an optional two-year registration system 18 whereby the registration of all vehicles shall be for a 19 period of twenty-four consecutive calendar months, the 20 expiration dates of the registrations to be staggered 21 throughout the year. Under this option, all annual fees 22 due at the time of registration shall be multiplied by two.
- 23 (1) On or after July 1, 1997, all Class A motor vehicles as
 24 defined in section one, article ten of this chapter shall be
 25 registered for a period of twelve or twenty-four consecu26 tive calendar months. There hereby are established twelve
 27 registration periods, each of which shall start on day one
 28 of each calendar month of the year and shall end on the
 29 last day of month twelve from date of beginning. The
 30 period ending on January 31 is designated the first period;
 31 that ending on February 28 or 29 is designated the second;
 32 that ending on March 31 is designated the third; that
 33 ending on April 30 is designated the fourth; that ending on
 34 May 31 is designated the fifth; that ending on June 30 is
 35 designated the sixth; that ending on July 31 is designated

- 36 the seventh; that ending on August 31 is designated the
- 37 eighth; that ending on September 30 is designated the
- 38 ninth; that ending on October 31 is designated the tenth;
- 39 that ending on November 30 is designated the eleventh;
- 40 and that ending on December 31 is designated the twelfth.
- 41 (2) All Class A motor vehicles which are operated for the
- 42 first time upon the public highways of this state to and
- 43 including day fifteen of any given month are subject to
- 44 registration and payment of the fee for the twelve- or 24-
- 45 month period commencing day one of the month of
- 46 operation. All Class A motor vehicles operated for the
- 47 first time upon the public highways of this state on and
- 48 after day sixteen of any given month are subject to
- 49 registration and payment of fee for the twelve or 24-month
- 50 period commencing day one of the month of the next
- 51 following calendar month.
- 52 (c) On or before July 1, 1996, all Class T and Class R
- 53 vehicles shall be registered for a maximum period of three
- 54 years or portion thereof based on the number of years
- 55 remaining in the three year period designated by the
- 56 commissioner.
- 57 (d) On or before July 1, 2000, all Class C trailers shall be
- 58 registered for the duration of the owner's interest in the
- 59 trailer and shall not expire until either sold or otherwise
- 60 permanently removed from the service of the owner.
- 61 (e) Notwithstanding the provisions of this section or of
- 62 any other provision of this chapter to the contrary, the
- 63 commissioner shall on or before July 1, 2010, offer an
- 64 optional two-year registration for Class G vehicles. The
- 65 commissioner may offer extended prorated registration
- 66 renewal cycles to accommodate changes in designated
- 67 expiration dates.

ARTICLE 10. FEES FOR REGISTRATION, LICENSING, ETC.

§17A-10-3. Registration fees for vehicles equipped with pneumatic tires.

- 1 The following registration fees for the classes indicated
- 2 shall be paid to the division for the registration of vehicles
- 3 subject to registration under this chapter when equipped
- 4 with pneumatic tires:
- 5 (a) Registration fees for the following classes shall be
- 6 paid to the division annually:
- 7 (1) Class A. The registration fee for all motor vehicles
- 8 of this class is \$28.50: *Provided*, That the registration fees
- 9 and any other fees required by this chapter for Class A
- 10 vehicles under the optional biennial staggered registration
- 11 system shall be multiplied by two and paid biennially to
- 12 the division.
- 13 No license fee may be charged for vehicles owned by
- 14 churches, or by trustees for churches, which are regularly
- 15 used for transporting parishioners to and from church
- 16 services. Notwithstanding the exemption, the certificate
- 17 of registration and license plates shall be obtained the
- 18 same as other cards and plates under this article.
- 19 (2) Class B. The registration fee for all motor vehicles
- 20 of this class is as follows:
- 21 (A) For declared gross weights of eight thousand one
- 22 pounds to sixteen thousand pounds \$28 plus \$5 for each
- 23 one thousand pounds or fraction of one thousand pounds
- 24 that the gross weight of the vehicle or combination of
- 25 vehicles exceeds eight thousand pounds.
- 26 (B) For declared gross weights greater than sixteen
- 27 thousand pounds, but less than fifty-five thousand pounds
- 28 \$78.50 plus \$10 for each one thousand or fraction of one

- 29 thousand pounds that the gross weight of the vehicle or
- 30 combination of vehicles exceeds sixteen thousand pounds.
- 31 (C) For declared gross weights of fifty-five thousand
- 32 pounds or more \$737.50 plus \$15.75 for each one thou-
- 33 sand pounds or fraction of one thousand pounds that the
- 34 gross weight of the vehicle or combination of vehicles
- 35 exceeds fifty-five thousand pounds.
- 36 (3) Class G. The registration fee for each motorcycle or
- 37 parking enforcement vehicle is \$8: Provided, That the
- 38 registration fee and any other fees required by this chapter
- 39 for Class G vehicles shall be for at least one year and
- 40 under an optional biennial registration system the annual
- 41 fee shall be multiplied by two and paid biennially to the
- 42 division.
- 43 (4) Class H. -The registration fee for all vehicles for this
- 44 class operating entirely within the state is \$5; and for
- 45 vehicles engaged in interstate transportation of persons,
- 46 the registration fee is the amount of the fees provided by
- 47 this section for Class B, reduced by the amount that the
- 48 mileage of the vehicles operated in states other than West
- 49 Virginia bears to the total mileage operated by the vehicles
- 50 in all states under a formula to be established by the
- 51 Division of Motor Vehicles.
- 52 (5) Class J. The registration fee for all motor vehicles
- 53 of this class is \$85. Ambulances and hearses used exclu-
- 54 sively as ambulances and hearses are exempt from the
- 55 special fees set forth in this section.
- 56 (6) Class M. The registration fee for all vehicles of this
- 57 class is \$17.50.
- 58 (7) Class farm truck. –The registration fee for all motor
- 59 vehicles of this class is as follows:
- 60 (A) For farm trucks of declared gross weights of eight
- 61 thousand one pounds to sixteen thousand pounds \$30.

- 62 (B) For farm trucks of declared gross weights of sixteen
- 63 thousand one pounds to twenty-two thousand pounds -
- 64 \$60.
- 65 (C) For farm trucks of declared gross weights of twenty-
- 66 two thousand one pounds to twenty-eight thousand
- 67 pounds \$90.
- 68 (D) For farm trucks of declared gross weights of twenty-
- 69 eight thousand one pounds to thirty-four thousand pounds
- 70 \$115.
- 71 (E) For farm trucks of declared gross weights of thirty-
- 72 four thousand one pounds to forty-four thousand pounds
- 73 \$160.
- 74 (F) For farm trucks of declared gross weights of forty-
- 75 four thousand one pounds to fifty-four thousand pounds
- 76 \$205.
- 77 (G) For farm trucks of declared gross weights of fifty-
- 78 four thousand one pounds to eighty thousand pounds -
- 79 \$250: Provided, That the provisions of subsection (a),
- 80 section eight, article one, chapter seventeen-e of this code
- 81 do not apply if the vehicle exceeds sixty-four thousand
- 82 pounds and is a truck tractor or road tractor.
- 83 (b) Registration fees for the following classes shall be
- 84 paid to the division for a maximum period of three years,
- 85 or portion of a year based on the number of years remain-
- 86 ing in the three-year period designated by the commis-
- 87 sioner:
- 88 (1) Class R. The annual registration fee for all vehicles
- 89 of this class is \$12.
- 90 (2) Class T. The annual registration fee for all vehicles
- 91 of this class is \$8.
- 92 (c) The fees paid to the division for a multiyear registra-
- 93 tion provided by this chapter shall be the same as the

- 94 annual registration fee established by this section and any 95 other fee required by this chapter multiplied by the 96 number of years for which the registration is issued.
- 97 (d) The registration fee for all Class C vehicles is \$50. On 98 or before July 1, 2000, all Class C trailers shall be regis-99 tered for the duration of the owner's interest in the trailer 100 and do not expire until either sold or otherwise perma-101 nently removed from the service of the owner: *Provided*, 102 That a registrant may transfer a Class C registration plate 103 from a trailer owned less than thirty days to another Class 104 C trailer titled in the name of the registrant upon payment 105 of the transfer fee prescribed in section ten of this article.
