20	§22A-6-11. Study of methane detecting shut off devices.
21	Study of Automatic shut-down of mining machines The Board
22	of Coal Mine Health and Safety is directed to conduct a study of
23	the safety of installation of methane detection shut-off devices on
24	machine extraction apparatus, including, but not limited to, long

wall sheers and cutter heads. The Office shall study the benefits and appropriateness of requiring the installation of these devices, to determine if there are safety benefits, and whether the Office recommends to the Legislature that requirements regarding mandating these devises in underground mines is warranted. The Office shall report to the Legislature's Joint Committee on Government and Finance by December 31, 2011 with recommendations regarding whether it is appropriate to implement any requirements.
