A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by  
adding thereto a new section, designated §15-2-5a, relating to  
providing a housing supplement for members of the State  
Police.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended  
by adding thereto a new section, designated §15-2-5a, to read as  
follows:

**ARTICLE 2. WEST VIRGINIA STATE POLICE.**

**§15-2-5a. Housing allowances.**

Beginning July 1, 2011, through July 1, 2013, each member of  
the State Police that resides in a county in which the average  
monthly mortgage payment upon residential property exceeds \$700, as  
determined by the Bureau of Census of the United States Department

1 of Commerce in the taking of the 2000 census of population, shall  
 2 receive an annual housing allowance supplement determined according  
 3 to the following schedule:

4	<u>Average monthly mortgage</u>	<u>Housing allowance supplement</u>
5	<u>\$700 to \$745</u>	<u>\$300</u>
6	<u>\$745.01 to \$760</u>	<u>\$600</u>
7	<u>\$760.01 to \$790</u>	<u>\$900</u>
8	<u>\$790.01 to \$820</u>	<u>\$1200</u>
9	<u>\$820.01 to \$850</u>	<u>\$1500</u>
10	<u>\$850.01 to \$890</u>	<u>\$1800</u>
11	<u>\$890.01 to \$930</u>	<u>\$2100</u>
12	<u>\$930.01 and above</u>	<u>\$2400</u>

13 The payments shall be made in equal monthly installments and  
 14 shall be considered a part of the state minimum salaries for  
 15 members of the State Police.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to provide a housing supplement for members of the State Police.

§15-2-5a section is new; therefore, it has been completely underscored.
