10	A BILL to amend and reenact $\$8-14-12$ of the Code of West Virginia,
11	1931, as amended, relating to municipal police departments;
12	increasing the maximum age for persons applying for
13	examination for original appointment to an applicable
14	municipal police civil system from thirty-five to forty years.
15	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
16	That §8-14-12 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended,
17	be amended and reenacted to read as follows:
18	ARTICLE 14. LAW AND ORDER; POLICE FORCE OR DEPARTMENTS; POWERS,
19	AUTHORITY AND DUTIES OF LAW-ENFORCEMENT OFFICIALS AND
20	POLICEMEN; POLICE MATRONS; SPECIAL SCHOOL ZONE AND PARKING LOT
21	OR PARKING BUILDING POLICE OFFICERS; CIVIL SERVICE FOR CERTAIN
22	POLICE DEPARTMENTS.
23	§8-14-12. Form of application; age and residency requirements;
24	exceptions.
25	(a) The policemen's civil service commission in each Class I
26	and Class II city shall require individuals a person applying for
27	admission to any competitive examination provided for under the

- 1 civil service provisions of this article or under the <u>commission's</u>
  2 rules <del>and regulations of said commission</del> to file in its office,
  3 within a reasonable time prior to the proposed examination, a
  4 formal application in which the applicant shall state under oath or
- 5 affirmation:
  6 (1) His The applicant's full name, residence and post-office

7 address;

- 8 (2) His The applicant's United States citizenship, age and the 9 place and date of his the applicant's birth;
- 10 (3) His The applicant's state of health and his the 11 applicant's physical capacity for the public service;
- 12 (4) His The applicant's business and employments and 13 residences for at least three previous years; and
- 14 (5) Such Other information as may reasonably be required,
  15 touching upon the applicant's qualifications and fitness for the
  16 public service.
- (b) Blank forms for such Applications shall be furnished by 18 the commission, without charge. to all individuals requesting the 19 same. The commission may require, in connection with such the 20 application, such the certificates of citizens, physicians and 21 others, having pertinent knowledge concerning the applicant, as the 22 good of the service may require.
- (c) No A application person may not submit an application for 24 original appointment shall be received if the individual applying 25 person is less than eighteen years of age or more than thirty-five 26 forty years of age at the date of his the individual's application:

- (d) Notwithstanding the requirements established in this 2 3 section, if any an applicant formerly served upon the paid police 4 department of the city to which he or she makes application, for a 5 period of more than his or her probationary period, and resigned 6 from the department at a time when there were no charges of 7 misconduct or other misfeasance pending against such the applicant, 8 within a period of two years next preceding the date of his or her 9 application, and at the time of his or her application resides 10 within the corporate limits of the city in which the paid police 11 department to which he the individual seeks appointment by 12 reinstatement is located, then such the individual shall be 13 eligible for appointment by reinstatement in the discretion of the 14 policemen's civil service commission. even though such The 15 applicant shall be may be over the age of thirty-five forty years. 16 and such The applicant, providing his or her former term of service 17 so justifies, may be appointed by reinstatement to the paid police 18 department without a competitive examination, but such the 19 applicant shall undergo a medical examination. and if such 20 individual shall be so appointed by reinstatement to the paid 21 police department, he The applicant shall be the lowest in rank in 22 the department next above the probationers of the department.
- (e) Any An applicant for original appointment must have been 24 a resident for one year, during some period of time prior to the 25 date of his or her application, of the city in which he the 26 applicant seeks to become a member of the paid police department:

1 Provided, That if the commission deems determines it necessary it 2 may consider for original appointment or for reinstatement under 3 the preceding proviso of this section, subsection, applicants who 4 are not residents of the city but who have been residents of the 5 county in which the city or any portion of the territory thereof is 6 located for a period of at least one year.
