16	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
17	That the Code of West Virginia, 1931 as amended, be amended by
18	adding thereto a new section, designated §22A-6-12, to read as
19	follows:
20	ARTICLE 6. BOARD OF COAL MINE HEALTH AND SAFETY.
21	§22A-6-12. Study of whistleblower protections.
22	Study of Whistleblower protections The Board of Coal Mine
23	Health and Safety is directed to conduct a study of the need to
24	expand protections for whistleblowers and other miners who refuse
25	to work in situations they perceive as unsafe in underground mines.

1 The board shall study the benefits and appropriateness of requiring 2 additional protections that will encourage miners to withdrawal 3 from and report unsafe working conditions. The Office shall 4 investigate whether any pattern of retribution exists against these 5 persons, and if so to make recommendations to the Legislature 6 regarding implementing additional protections. The Board shall report to the Legislature's Joint Committee on Government and 7 8 Finance by December 31, 2011 with recommendations regarding whether 9 it is appropriate to implement any additional protections.
