| 10     | A BILL to amend and reenact $\$15-1B-21$ of the Code of West Virginia,   |

| 15     | Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:   |
| 16     | That §15-1B-21 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended,   |
| 17     | be amended and reenacted to read as follows:   |
| 18     | ARTICLE 1B. NATIONAL GUARD.  |
| 19     | §15-1B-21. Tuition and fees for guard members at institutions of   |
| 20     | higher education.  |
| 21     | (a) Any member of the Army National Guard or Air National  |
| 22     | Guard who is enrolled in a course of undergraduate study or a an   |
| 23     | educational program which leads to a certificate, undergraduate  |
| 24     | degree, master's degree, doctor of medicine, or doctor of  |
| 25     | osteopathic medicine, program and is attending any accredited  |
| 26     | community and technical college, college, university, or business,   |

1 or career-technical, vocational, trade or aviation school, located 2 in West Virginia or is attending any aviation school located in 3 West Virginia for the purpose of taking college-credit courses, may 4 be entitled to payment of tuition and fees at that college, 5 university, business, or trade school or aviation school for that 6 program during the period of his or her service in the National 7 Guard.

8 (1) The Adjutant General may prescribe criteria of eligibility 9 for payment of tuition and fees. at the college, university, 10 business or trade school or aviation school The payment is 11 contingent upon appropriations being made by the Legislature for 12 this the express purpose of this section.

13 (2) A member may receive payment for only one <u>certificate</u>, 14 <u>undergraduate degree and</u> master's degree pursuant to this section. 15 (3) Not more than two members a year may be selected by the 16 <u>Adjutant General to receive payment for either a doctor of medicine</u> 17 <u>or doctor of osteopathic medicine degree program. Any candidate</u>

18 <u>selected for this program must remain a member of the Army National</u>
19 <u>Guard or the Air National Guard and practice medicine in the State</u>
20 <u>of West Virginia for a minimum of ten years after receiving a</u>
21 <u>doctor of medicine or doctor of osteopathic medicine degree, or be</u>
22 <u>subject to recoupment for all monies paid pursuant to this</u>
23 <u>subdivision.</u>

(b) The amount of the payment for members <u>a member</u> attending 25 a state-supported school <del>shall be</del> <u>is</u> determined by the Adjutant 26 General and may not exceed the actual <del>amount</del> <u>cost</u> of tuition and

1 fees at the school. The amount of the payment for members <u>a member</u> 2 attending a private school <del>shall be</del> <u>is</u> determined by the Adjutant 3 General <del>but in any event</del> <u>and</u> may not exceed the highest <del>amounts</del> 4 <u>amount</u> payable at any state-supported school.

5 (c) Any member of the Army National Guard or Air National 6 Guard who is enrolled in a course of undergraduate study, or a 7 master's degree program and is attending any accredited college or 8 university located in West Virginia and is receiving payments under 9 a federally funded continuing education system <u>and is eligible to</u> 10 receive tuition and fee payments pursuant to this section may be 11 entitled to payment of tuition and fees <del>at that college or</del> 12 university during his or her period of service in the Army National 13 Guard or Air National Guard: *Provided*, That <u>under this section</u> and a 15 federally funded continuing education system may not exceed the 16 actual amount of tuition and fees at the school and in <del>no</del> <u>any</u> event 17 may <u>not</u> exceed the highest <u>amounts</u> <u>amount</u> payable at any state-18 supported school. The payments are contingent upon appropriations

19 being made by the Legislature for this express purpose.

(d) The Adjutant General may, in lieu of the tuition payment authorized by this section, pay an amount equal to the amount of tuition which otherwise would have been paid directly to members For any member of the West Virginia Army National Guard or West Virginia Air National Guard who are is participating in the PROMISE Scholarship program provided in article seven, chapter eighteen-c of this code, the Adjutant General may pay directly to the member

1 an amount equal to the amount of tuition and fees which otherwise
2 would have been paid to the school.

3 (e) A member of the West Virginia Army National Guard or West 4 Virginia Air National Guard who is receiving payments for tuition 5 and fees under this section and is discharged from the military 6 service due to wounds or injuries received in the line of duty may 7 continue to receive payments for tuition and fees under this 8 section as if he or she were still a member.

9 (f) The Adjutant General shall administer the tuition and fee 10 payments authorized under this section and shall propose <u>establish</u> 11 policies to implement the provisions of this section.
