14	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
15	That $4-2-5$ of the code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended,
16	be amended and reenacted to read as follows:
17	ARTICLE 2. LEGISLATIVE AUDITOR; POWERS; FUNCTIONS; DUTIES;
18	COMPENSATION.
19	§4-2-5. Powers of Auditor.
20	<u>(a) (1)</u> The Legislative Auditor <del>shall have</del> <u>has</u> the power and
21	authority to examine the revenues, expenditures and performance of
22	every spending unit of the state government or entity created by
23	this code and for , and of every public or private entity which is
24	the recipient of state funds, including funds derived from a state
25	controlled function, to the extent necessary to ascertain that the
26	funds are properly expended and reported.
27	(2) For these purposes the Legislative Auditor has shall have
28	the authority, by such means as are necessary, to require:

1 <u>(A) Any any person holding office in the state government or</u> 2 employed by the state, to allow <u>him the Legislative Auditor or his</u> 3 <u>or her employee or designee</u> to inspect the properties, equipment, 4 facilities and records of the various agencies, departments, 5 subdivisions or institutions of the state government for which 6 appropriations are to be made or have been made, either before or 7 after estimates therefor are submitted, and before, during and 8 after the sessions of the Legislature<del>.</del>; and

9 <u>(B) Any public or private entity which is the recipient of</u> 10 state funds, including funds derived from a state controlled 11 function, to allow the Legislative Auditor or his or her employee 12 or designee to inspect the properties, equipment, facilities and 13 records of the entity to the extent necessary to ascertain that the 14 state funds, including funds derived from a state controlled 15 function, are properly expended and reported: *Provided*, That the 16 Legislative Auditor may only review state funds or invoices for 17 services provided to the state.

18 (b) Refusal of any person to allow such the inspection shall 19 be reported by the Legislative Auditor to the committee.

20 (c) The Legislative Auditor shall provide any person or entity 21 audited pursuant to this section a copy of the audit report, and 22 shall allow the person or entity an opportunity to respond to the 23 audit report in accordance with generally accepted governmental 24 accounting practices.

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
