20	§18-2-7d. Course of study in fetal development.
21	The State Board of Education, with the advice of the State
22	Superintendent of Schools, shall prescribe a curriculum to teach
23	fetal development. Each high school in the state shall include in

- 1 their health classes the course of study for its students. Nothing
- 2 in this section may be construed or interpreted to endorse, allow,
- 3 permit or approve of any abortion.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require all high schools include in their health classes a course in fetal development.
