

1 sale of alcoholic liquors as early as one a.m. However, clubs that
2 also hold limited video lottery licenses may continue to remain
3 open to their patrons but must stop the sale of alcoholic liquors
4 at one a.m. This section does not apply to racetracks that are
5 licensed to conduct video lottery games.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to grant the authority to counties and municipalities to curtail the serving of alcoholic beverages by licensed clubs as early as one a.m. The bill also provides that those clubs that also hold video lottery licenses may continue to remain open for lottery patrons but must cease serving alcoholic liquors at 1 a.m.
