15	That \$17C-15-23 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as
16	amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:
17	ARTICLE 15. EQUIPMENT.
18	§17C-15-23. Lighting equipment on motorcycles, motor-driven
19	cycles and mopeds.
20	The head lamp or head lamps upon every motorcycle, motor-
21	driven cycle and moped may be of the single-beam or multiple-beam
22	type but in either event shall comply with the requirements and
23	limitations as follows:

(1) Every said head lamp or head lamps shall be of sufficient

- 20 <u>(4) Motorcycles, motor-driven cycles and mopeds may have</u>
- 21 lights that are underneath the body and turned on while the
- 22 motorcycle, motor-driven cycle or moped is being operated at night.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to permit running lamps on motorcycles, motor-driven cycles and mopeds.
