10 A BILL to amend and reenact article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of
11 West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the
12 Board of Osteopathy to promulgate a legislative rule relating
13 to fees for services rendered by the Board.

14 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

15 That article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,
16 as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

17 **ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO**
18 **PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

19 **§64-9-1. Board of Osteopathy.**

20 The legislative rule filed in the state register on the
21 twenty-eighth day of July, two thousand ten, authorized under the
22 authority of section three, article fourteen-a, chapter thirty, of
23 this code, modified by the Board of Osteopathy to meet the
24 objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and
25 refiled in the state register on the twenty-ninth day of November,

1 two thousand ten, relating to the Board of Osteopathy (fees for
2 services rendered by the Board, 24 CSR 5), is authorized.

4 NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of
5 Osteopathy to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Fees for
6 Services Rendered by the Board.
