14 A BILL to amend and reenact article 3, chapter 64 of the Code of
15 West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the
16 Department of Environmental Protection to promulgate a
17 legislative rule relating to explosives and blasting.

18 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

19 That article 3, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,
20 as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

21 **ARTICLE 3. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL**
22 **PROTECTION TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

23 **§64-3-1. Department of Environmental Protection.**

24 The legislative rule filed in the state register on the

1 thirtieth day of July, two thousand ten, authorized under the
2 authority of section four, article three-a, chapter twenty-two, of
3 this code, modified by the Department of Environmental Protection
4 to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review
5 Committee and refiled in the state register on the eighteenth day
6 of January, two thousand eleven, relating to the Department of
7 Environmental Protection (explosives and blasting, 199 CSR 1), is
8 authorized.

10 NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Department
11 of Environmental Protection to promulgate a legislative rule
12 relating to Explosives and Blasting.
