16	ARTICLE 2. WILDLIFE RESOURCES.
17	$\S20-2-21$ . Reporting beaver and river otter pelts taken and tagged.
18	Each trapper shall present each <del>Castor canadensis</del> beaver <u>and</u>
19	river otter, or its each pelt, to a game checking station or
20	representative of the division within thirty days after the close
21	of a legal season. A tag provided by the division shall be affixed
22	to each <del>Castor canadensis</del> <u>beaver and river otter</u> , or <u>each</u> pelt and
23	remain attached to the $\underline{\text{animal or}}$ pelt until it is processed into
