- 1 All new facility projects of public agencies and all facility
- 2 projects receiving state funds, including public schools, shall be
- 3 designed and constructed complying with the International Code
- 4 Council 2009 International Energy Conservation Code and the
- 5 ANSI/ASHRAE/IESNA Standard 90.1-2007. This provision applies to
- 6 projects that have not entered the schematic design phase prior to
- 7 July 1, 2011.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require new facility projects of public agencies and projects receiving state funds, to be designed and constructed complying with the *International Code Council 2009 International Energy Conservation Code* and the ANSI/ASHRAE/IESNA Standard 90.1-2007.
