10 A BILL to amend and reenact article 5, chapter 64 of the Code of
11 West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the
12 Department of Health and Human Resources to promulgate a
13 legislative rule relating to maternal risk screening.

14 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

15 That article 5, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,
16 as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

17 **ARTICLE 5. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN**
18 **RESOURCES TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

19 **§64-5-1. Department of Health and Human Resources.**

20 The legislative rule filed in the state register on the
21 twenty-ninth day of July, two thousand ten, authorized under the
22 authority of section four, article four-e, chapter sixteen, of this

1 code, modified by the Department of Health and Human Resources to
2 meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee
3 and refiled in the state register on the third day of January, two
4 thousand eleven, relating to the Department of Health and Human
5 Resources (maternal risk screening, 64 CSR 97), is authorized.

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7 NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Department
8 of Health and Human Resources to promulgate a legislative rule
9 relating to Maternal Risk Screening.

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11 This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and
12 underscoring have been omitted.
