16	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
17	That $\$17-2D-2$ and $\$17-2D-5$ of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,
18	as amended, be amended and reenacted, all to read as follows:
19	ARTICLE 2D. HIGHWAY DESIGN-BUILD PILOT PROGRAM.
20	§17-2D-2. Highway Design-Build Pilot Program.
21	(a) Notwithstanding any provision of this code to the
22	contrary, the Commissioner of the West Virginia Division of
23	Highways may continue with the pilot program to expedite the
24	construction of no more than ten special projects, in addition to

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- 1 the three projects authorized by prior enactment of this section,
- 2 by combining the design and construction elements of a highway or
- 3 bridge project into a single contract.
- 4 (b) A design-build project may not be let to contract after
- 5 June 30, 2011 2013. The Division of Highways may expend no more
- 6 than \$50 million in each of the three years remaining in the pilot
- 7 program, for an aggregate total of \$150 million.
- 8 (c) A design-build project may be let to contract only in
- 9 accordance with the commissioner's established policies and
- 10 procedures concerning design-build projects.
- 11 (d) After June 30, 2011 2013, no projects may not be let under

- 2 any cost or time savings, the number and cost of change orders, the
