21	The legislative rule filed in the state register on the
22	thirtieth day of July, two thousand ten, authorized under the

authority of section six, article four-c, chapter sixteen, of this code, modified by the Department of Health and Human Resources to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the state register on the twenty-fourth day of January, two thousand eleven, relating to the Department of Health and Human Resources (emergency medical services, 64 CSR 48), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Department of Health and Human Resources to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Emergency Medical Services.
