18	Retail licensees may not sell liquor on Sundays <u>and</u> Christmas <del>or</del>
19	election day, or between the hours of twelve midnight and eight
20	o'clock a.m., except that wine and fortified wines may be sold on
21	such those days and at such times as authorized in section
22	thirty-four, article eight of this chapter.
