A BILL to amend and reenact §4-2-5 of the code of West Virginia,

1931 as amended, relating to the powers and duties of the
Legislative Auditor; allowing reports to be generated by the
Legislative Auditor and authorizing audits of state funds.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That §4-2-5 of the code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 2. LEGISLATIVE AUDITOR; POWERS; FUNCTIONS; DUTIES; COMPENSATION.

§4-2-5. Powers of Auditor.

1	(a) (1) The Legislative Auditor shall have has the power
2	and authority to examine the revenues, expenditures and
3	performance of every spending unit of the state government
4	or entity created by this code and for, and of every public or
5	private entity which is the recipient of state funds, including
6	funds derived from a state controlled function, to the extent
7	necessary to ascertain that the funds are properly expended
8	and reported.
9	(2) For these purposes the Legislative Auditor has shall
10	have the authority, by such means as are necessary, to
11	require:
12	(A) Any any person holding office in the state
13	government or employed by the state, to allow him the
14	Legislative Auditor or his or her employee or designee to
15	inspect the properties, equipment, facilities and records of the
16	various agencies, departments, subdivisions or institutions of
17	the state government for which appropriations are to be made
18	or have been made, either before or after estimates therefore
19	are submitted, and before, during and after the sessions of the
20	Legislature: ; and
21	(B) Any public or private entity which is the recipient of
22	state funds, including funds derived from a state controlled

23	function, to allow the Legislative Auditor or his or her
24	employee or designee to inspect the properties, equipment,
25	facilities and records of the entity to the extent necessary to
26	ascertain that the state funds, including funds derived from a
27	state controlled function, are properly expended and reported:
28	Provided, That the Legislative Auditor may only review state
29	funds or invoices for services provided to the state.
30	(b) Refusal of any person to allow such the inspection
31	shall be reported by the Legislative Auditor to the committee.
32	(c) The Legislative Auditor shall provide any person or
33	entity audited pursuant to this section a copy of the audit
34	report, and shall allow the person or entity an opportunity to
35	respond to the audit report in accordance with generally
36	accepted governmental accounting practices.

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
