

Senate Bill No. 254

(By Senators Kessler (Acting President) and Hall,
By Request of the Executive)

[Introduced January 25, 2011; referred to
the Committee on Finance.]

A BILL making a supplementary appropriation of federal funds out of the Treasury from the balance of federal moneys remaining unappropriated for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, to the West Virginia Development Office - Community Development, fund 8746, fiscal year 2011, organization 0307, and to Division of Human Services - Energy Assistance, fund 8755, fiscal year 2011, organization 0511, by supplementing and amending the appropriations for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011.

WHEREAS, The Governor has established the availability of federal funds now available for expenditure in the fiscal year

ending June 30, 2011 which are hereby appropriated by the terms of this supplementary appropriation bill; therefore

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That the total appropriation for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, to fund 8746, fiscal year 2011, organization 0307, be supplemented and amended by increasing an existing item of appropriation as follows:
