10	A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by
11	adding thereto a new section, designated §18-2E-8g, relating
12	to recognizing outstanding students who are top scorers on
13	certain statewide tests and providing rule-making authority to
14	the state board.
15	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
16	That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended
17	by adding thereto a new section, designated §18-2E-8g, to read as
18	follows:
19	ARTICLE 2E. HIGH QUALITY EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS.
20	<u>§18-2E-8g. Recognition of outstanding students.</u>
21	The state board shall establish a program to recognize
22	outstanding students whose scores are in the top ten of all
23	students in the public schools of the state in each subject area
24	tested under the statewide summative assessment known as the
25	WESTEST2 or any successor tests, in each grade level tested. These
26	students shall receive recognition as being "All State" students in

1 <u>their respective scholastic categories and grade levels.</u> The
2 <u>recognition of students under this program shall be in addition to,</u>
3 <u>but may be integrated with, any other state or county board program</u>
4 <u>for recognizing the scholastic abilities of students.</u> The state
5 <u>board shall promulgate a rule for implementation of this program</u>
6 <u>during the 2012 - 2013 school year.</u>
