17	ARTICLE 9. OFFENSES AND PENALTIES.
18	<u>§3-9-14. Absentee ballot fraud; intimidation of voters;</u>
19	penalties.
20	Any person who, with the intent to commit fraud, obtains,
21	removes, completes or disseminates an absentee ballot or
22	intimidates an absentee voter, is guilty of a felony and, upon
23	conviction thereof, shall be fined not less than \$10,000 nor more
24	than \$20,000 or imprisoned in a state correctional facility not
25	less than one nor more than five years, or both fined and
26	imprisoned.
