10 A BILL to amend and reenact article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of
11 West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the Board
12 of Barbers and Cosmetologists to promulgate a legislative rule
13 relating to shampoo assistants.

14 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

15 That article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,
16 as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

17 **ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO**
18 **PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

19 **§64-9-1. Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists.**

20 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on the
21 twenty-ninth day of July, two thousand eleven, authorized under the
22 authority of section eleven-a, article twenty-seven, chapter
23 thirty, of this code, relating to the Board of Barbers and
24 Cosmetologists (shampoo assistants, [3 CSR 8](#)), is authorized.

1 NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of
2 Barbers and Cosmetologists to promulgate a legislative rule
3 relating to Shampoo Assistants.
