10 A BILL to amend and reenact article 7, chapter 64 of the Code of
11 West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the
12 Alcohol Beverage Control Commission to promulgate a
13 legislative rule relating to licensed retailer operations.

14 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

15 That article 7, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,
16 as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

17 **ARTICLE 7. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF TAX AND REVENUE TO**
18 **PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

19 **§64-7-1. Alcohol Beverage Control Commission.**

20 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on the
21 thirteenth day of July, two thousand eleven, authorized under the
22 authority of section six, article three-a, chapter sixty, of this
23 code, modified by the Alcohol Beverage Control Commission to meet
24 the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and
25 refiled in the State Register on the twenty-first day of November,
26 two thousand eleven, relating to the Alcohol Beverage Commission

1 (licensed retailer operations, [175 CSR 1](#)), is authorized.

3 NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Alcohol
4 Beverage Commission to promulgate a legislative rule relating to
5 Licensed Retailer Operations.
