10 A BILL to amend and reenact article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of
11 West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the
12 Athletic Commission to promulgate a legislative rule relating
13 to mixed martial arts.

14 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

15 That article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,
16 as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

17 **ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO**
18 **PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

19 **§64-9-1. Athletic Commission.**

20 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on the
21 twenty-eighth day of July, two thousand eleven, authorized under
22 the authority of section three-a, article five-a, chapter twenty-
23 nine, of this code, modified by the Athletic Commission to meet the
24 objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and
25 refiled in the State Register on the sixth day of January, two
26 thousand twelve, relating to the Athletic Commission (mixed martial

1 arts, [177 CSR 2](#)), is authorized.

3 NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Athletic
4 Commission to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Mixed
5 Martial Arts.
