10	A BILL to amend and reenact §8-11-3, of the Code of West Virginia,
11	1931 as amended, relating to municipalities; enactment of
12	ordinances; and removing the requirement that a municipality
13	must pass an ordinance to adopt a contract with another
14	jurisdiction.
15	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
16	That §8-11-3, of the Code of West Virginia, 1931 as amended,
17	be amended and reenacted to read as follows:
18	ARTICLE 11. POWERS AND DUTIES WITH RESPECT TO ORDINANCES AND
19	ORDINANCE PROCEDURES.
20	§8-11-3. Cases requiring enactment of ordinance.
21	In the following enumerated cases, the action of a governing
22	body shall, except where otherwise provided in this code, be by
23	ordinance:
24	(1) Levying taxes or providing for the collection of fees of

- 2 (2) Requiring a license to do business;
- 3 (3) Relating to offenses and penalties;
- 4 (4) Authorizing the issuance of bonds or other forms of 5 indebtedness;
- 6 (5) Providing for a public improvement;
- 7 (6) Providing for the purchase of private property by the
- 8 municipality or for the sale of property belonging to the
- 9 municipality;
- 10 (7) Laying out or vacating a public street, avenue, road,
- 11 alley or way;
- 12 (8) Relating to planning and zoning;
- 13 (9) Granting franchises to public utilities; and
- 14 (10) Providing for a contractual or other agreement with
- 15 another jurisdiction; and
- 16  $\frac{(11)}{(10)}$  Relating to such other matters as the charter may
- 17 require.
- 18 The action of a governing body shall also be by ordinance in
- 19 any other case in which an ordinance is required by the provisions
- 20 of this code.

NOTE: The purpose of the bill is remove the requirement that a municipality must pass an ordinance to adopt a contract with another jurisdiction.
