22	and antique motor vehicles in "as is" condition. A classic or

- 1 expressed nor an implied warranty attached and the dealer is not
- 2 responsible for correcting any defect or condition which
- 3 <u>substantially impairs the use or market value of the motor vehicle</u>
- 4 to the consumer.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to permit dealers to sell classic and antique motor vehicles in "as is" condition. The bill also provides that such a vehicle has neither an expressed nor an implied warranty attached.
