16	That §30-27-10 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended,
17	be amended and reenacted to read as follows:
18	ARTICLE 27. BOARD OF BARBERS AND COSMETOLOGISTS.
19	§30-27-10. Professional license and certificate renewal
20	requirements.
21	(a) A professional licensee and certificate holder shall
22	annually or biennially on or before January 1, renew his or her
23	professional license or certificate by completing a form prescribed

- 1 by the board, paying the renewal fee and submitting any other
- 2 information required by the board.
- 3 (b) The board shall charge a fee for each renewal of a license
- 4 or certificate, and a late fee for any renewal not paid by the due
- 5 date.
- 6 (c) The board shall require as a condition of renewal of a
- 7 professional license or certificate that each licensee or
- 8 certificate holder complete continuing education: Provided, That
- 9 barbers who have been licensed in West Virginia for thirty years or
- 10 more are exempt from the continuing education requirement of this
- 11 subsection.
- 12 (d) The board may deny an application for renewal for any
- 13 reason which would justify the denial of an original application
- 14 for a license or certificate.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to exempt barbers licensed in West Virginia for thirty years or more from continuing education requirements.
