3 (b) (1) No employer may require any employee to work without
4 a rest period of at least ten minutes during each four hours
5 worked.

6 (2) In situations in which the employee's work assignment
7 allows the employee to take intermittent rest periods equivalent to
8 ten minutes for each four hours worked, scheduled rest periods are
9 not required.

10 (3) The provisions of this subsection do not apply to those
11 employees who are subject to the Federal Railway Labor Act.

12 (4) The rest periods required by this subsection are in
13 addition to the regularly scheduled meal breaks required by
14 subsection (a) of this section.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require ten minute rest periods for certain employees during each four-hour period of work.
