19	§18-5-14a. Policies to promote school attendance.
20	(a) The board of education of each county may develop, modify,
21	implement and enforce policies designed to promote school
22	attendance. The policies may include, but are not limited to:
23	(1) Reducing grades or denying credit for courses in which a
24	student has excessive unexcused absences;
25	(2) Requiring a student to make up a predetermined number of

- 1 unexcused absences in order to receive credit for a course or
- 2 preserve a grade in that course;
- 3 (3) Allowing a student who has attended a predetermined number
- 4 of classes to elect to have the grade received on an end of the
- 5 grading period test for that class disregarded in the calculation
- 6 of the grade reported for that period; and
- 7 (4) Providing incentives for students whose attendance
- 8 satisfies certain predetermined conditions.
- 9 (b) County boards may use school funds to support incentive
- 10 programs implemented in accordance with the policies.
