18	ARTICLE 9A. Classification and compensation
19	<pre>§18B-9A-9. Extension of deadlines.</pre>
20	(a) The deadline of December 1, 2011, set out in subsection
21	(a), section eight, article seven of this chapter, for an initial
22	report on the progress in designing, developing, implementing and
23	administering the personnel classification and compensation

1 system for higher education is extended to December 1, 2012.

2 (b) The deadline of October 1, 2011, set out in subsection 3 (a), section nine, article seven of this chapter, for an initial 4 human resources review of each higher education organization is 5 extended to June 30, 2012.

6 (c) The deadline of January 1, 2012, set out in section 7 sixteen, article seven of this chapter, for a completion of a study 8 of certain employment practices is extended to June 30, 2012.

9 (d) The deadline of July 1, 2012, set out in subsection (g), 10 section four of this article, to have up-to-date job descriptions 11 for every classified position is extended to December 1, 2012.

12 (e) The deadline of November 1, 2011, set out in section seven 13 of this article, to propose emergency rules and legislative rules 14 to implement the provisions of this article and articles seven, 15 eight and nine of this chapter is extended to July 1, 2012.

16 (f) The deadline of December 1, 2011, set out in subdivision 17 five, subsection (b), section eight of this article, to report the 18 findings of the necessity of a human resources information system 19 is extended to June 30, 2012.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to extend certain deadlines mandated actions regarding higher education personnel.

\$18B-9A-9 is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.

This bill was recommended for introduction and passage during

the 2012 Regular Session of the Legislature by the Legislative Oversight Commission on Education Accountability.
