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5 [Introduced January 18, 2012; referred to the Committee on Health  
6 and Human Resources; and then to the Committee on the Judiciary.]

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10 A BILL to amend and reenact article 5, chapter 64 of the Code of  
11 West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the  
12 Department of Health and Human Resources to promulgate a  
13 legislative rule relating to manufactured home communities.

14 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

15 That article 5, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,  
16 as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

17 **ARTICLE 5. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN**  
18 **RESOURCES TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

19 **§64-5-1. Department of Health and Human Resources.**

20 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on the  
21 twenty-ninth day of July, two thousand eleven, authorized under the  
22 authority of section four, article one, chapter sixteen, of this

1 code, modified by the Department of Health and Human Resources to  
2 meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee  
3 and refiled in the State Register on the first day of December, two  
4 thousand eleven, relating to the Department of Health and Human  
5 Resources (manufactured home communities, [64 CSR 40](#)), is  
6 authorized.

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8 NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Department  
9 of Health and Human Resources to promulgate a legislative rule  
10 relating to Manufactured Home Communities.
