

Senate Bill No. 516

(By Senators K. Facemyer and Unger)

[Introduced February 6, 2012; referred to the Committee on
Government Organization; and then to the Committee on the
Judiciary.]

11 A BILL to amend and reenact §60-2-16 of the Code of West Virginia,
12 1931, as amended, relating to the state control of alcoholic
13 liquors; the Alcohol Beverage Control Commissioner; and
14 requiring training of all persons who serve alcoholic
15 beverages.

16 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

17 That §60-2-16 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended,
18 be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

19 **ARTICLE 2. ALCOHOL BEVERAGE CONTROL COMMISSIONER.**

20 **§60-2-16. Rules.**

21 The commission ~~shall have the power to prescribe rules and~~
22 ~~regulations~~ shall propose rules for legislative approval in
23 accordance with the provisions of article three, chapter twenty-
24 nine-a of this code to give effect to the powers vested in it by

1 this chapter. On or before July 1, 2012, the commission shall
2 propose rules requiring mandatory training for all persons who
3 serve any alcoholic liquor beverage, as defined in section five of
4 this article, and subject to regulation by this chapter. Rules ~~and~~
5 ~~regulations~~ shall be recorded in a book especially kept for that
6 purpose, and in its discretion may be published for general
7 circulation. All other records and entries necessary to show the
8 official conduct of the commission shall be preserved and shall be
9 public records and open for inspection during business hours.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require training of all persons who service alcoholic beverages.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from the present law, and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
