        That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended

22 §15-1B-27. Asset Forfeiture and Asset Sharing.
        (a) When the West Virginia National Guard Counterdrug Support

- 1 Program, established pursuant to 32 U.S.C. §112, assists or
- 2 supports a federal law-enforcement agency in enforcing drug laws,
- 3 the West Virginia National Guard Counterdrug Support Program is
- 4 authorized to participate in the sharing of any property seized or

- (b) For the foregoing purposes, there is hereby created in the
- 7 State Treasury a special revenue account, designated the West
