

Senate Bill No. 424

(By Senators D. Facemire, Klempa, Green, Yost and Tucker)

[Introduced January 25, 2012; referred to
the Committee on Government Organization.]

A BILL to amend and reenact §30-27-10 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to the Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists; and exempting barbers licensed in West Virginia for thirty years or more from continuing education requirements.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That §30-27-10 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 27. BOARD OF BARBERS AND COSMETOLOGISTS.

§30-27-10. Professional license and certificate renewal requirements.

- 1 (a) A professional licensee and certificate holder shall
- 2 annually or biennially on or before January 1, renew his or
- 3 her professional license or certificate by completing a form
- 4 prescribed by the board, paying the renewal fee and submit-
- 5 ting any other information required by the board.

6 (b) The board shall charge a fee for each renewal of a
7 license or certificate, and a late fee for any renewal not paid
8 by the due date.

9 (c) The board shall require as a condition of renewal of
10 a professional license or certificate that each licensee or
11 certificate holder complete continuing education: Provided,
12 That barbers who have been licensed in West Virginia for
13 thirty years or more are exempt from the continuing educa-
14 tion requirement of this subsection.

15 (d) The board may deny an application for renewal for
16 any reason which would justify the denial of an original
17 application for a license or certificate.

(NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to exempt barbers licensed in West Virginia for thirty years or more from continuing education requirements.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from the present law, and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.)
