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13	A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by
14	adding thereto a new article, designated §19-20C-1, §19-20C-2
15	and §19-20C-3, all relating to establishing the West Virginia
16	Spay Neuter Program and Fund; designating the Commissioner of
17	the Department of Agriculture to manage the program and fund;
18	providing grants to nonprofit spay neuter programs in state;
19	limiting administrative expenses of fund; requiring annual
20	reporting; and authorizing rulemaking.
21	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
22	That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended
23	by adding thereto a new article, designated §19-20C-1, §19-20C-2
24	and §19-20C-3, all to read as follows:

1 ARTICLE 20C. WEST VIRGINIA SPAY NEUTER PROGRAM.

2 §19-20C-1. West Virginia Spay Neuter Program.

3 The Department of Agriculture shall establish a spay neuter 4 assistance program that provides grants to nonprofit spay neuter 5 organizations and programs in the state. The purpose of this 6 program is to have more dogs and cats sterilized, thereby reducing 7 shelter populations and costs, euthanasia rates, and threats to 8 public health and safety from rabies and other problems posed by 9 the growing population of stray, feral and abandoned dogs and cats.

10 §19-20C-2. Fund established; acceptance of funds.

(a) There is created in the State Treasury a special revenue account to be designated the West Virginia Spay Neuter Fund. Sependitures from the fund are for the purposes set forth in this article and are to be made in accordance with appropriation by the Equivalent and in accordance with the provisions of article three, chapter twelve of this code and upon the fulfillment of the provisions set forth in article two, chapter eleven-b of this code. (b) All moneys received and collected pursuant to this article shall be deposited into the fund. The fund may receive any

20 appropriations, gifts, grants, contributions or other money from 21 any source that is designated for deposit into the fund.

(c) Administrative expenses of the department may not exceed the percent of the funds deposited in any fiscal year. The remainder shall be used exclusively for implementation of the

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1 program.

2 §19-20C-3. Rulemaking; annual report.

3 (a) The commissioner shall propose rules for legislative 4 approval in accordance with article three, chapter twenty-nine-a of 5 this code, to implement the provisions of this article.

6 (b) Rules promulgated under this section shall, at a minimum: 7 (1) Identify the types of nonprofit organizations and programs 8 that qualify for spay neuter grants;

9 (2) Establish parameters for spay neuter grants, and 10 procedures and requirements for grant application; and

(3) Establish administration, record keeping and reporting requirements for nonprofit organizations and programs that receive spay neuter grants.

14 (c) Beginning the year following the program's inception, the 15 commissioner shall file an annual report to the Joint Committee on 16 Government and Finance regarding the program, funds received and 17 grants awarded, number of dogs and cats sterilized, and other 18 pertinent data.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to create West Virginia Spay Neuter Program and Fund.

Article 20C is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.

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
