 $\S64-9-1$. Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists.

The legislative rule filed in the State Register on the twenty-ninth day of June, two thousand twelve, authorized under the authority of section six, article twenty-seven, chapter thirty, of this code, relating to the Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists (procedures, criteria and curricula for examination and licensure of barbers, cosmetologists, nail technicians, aestheticians and hair stylists, 3 CSR 1), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists to promulgate a legislative rule relating to the Procedures, Criteria and Curricula for Examination and Licensure of Barbers, Cosmetologists, Nail Technicians, Aestheticians and Hair Stylists.
