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10	A BILL to amend and reenact $\$30-4-13$ of the Code of West Virginia,
11	1931, as amended; and to amend said code by adding thereto a
12	new section, designated $$30-4-13a$ , all relating to the
13	practice of dentistry; and updating the requirements for
14	dental intern, dental resident and dental teaching permits.
15	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
16	That §30-4-13 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended,
17	be amended and reenacted; and that said code be amended by adding
18	thereto a new section, designated §30-4-13a, all to read as
19	follows:
20	ARTICLE 4. WEST VIRGINIA DENTAL PRACTICE ACT.
21	§30-4-13. Dental intern or dental resident permit.
22	(a) The board may issue a dental intern or dental resident
23	permit to an applicant who:

(1) Has been accepted as a dental intern or dental resident by

- 1 a licensed hospital or dental school with an established dental
  2 department;
- 3 (2) Is under the supervision of a licensed dentist;
- 4 (3) Has graduated with a degree in dentistry from an 5 accredited dental college, school or dental department of a 6 university;
- 7 (4) Has paid the applicable fees; and
- 8 (5) Meets any other requirements specified by the board.
- 9 (b) The dental intern or dental resident permit may be renewed
- 10 and expires on the earlier of:
- 11 (1) The date the permit holder ceases to be a dental intern or
- 12 dental resident; or
- 13 (2) One year after the date of issue.
- 14 (c) While the dental intern or dental resident permit is in 15 effect, a permittee is:
- 16 (1) Subject to the restrictions and requirements imposed by 17 this article; and
- 18 (2) Not allowed to receive any fee for service, other than a 19 salary paid by the hospital or dental school.
- 20 §30-4-13a. Dental teaching permit.
- 21 (a) The board may issue a dental teaching permit to an 22 applicant who is not licensed to practice dentistry in this state
- 23 and who meets the following conditions:
- 24 (1) Shall have an authorization to practice dentistry in

- 1 another jurisdiction or has been eligible for an authorization to
- 2 practice dentistry in another jurisdiction; and
- 3 (2) Has met, or been approved under, the credentialing
- 4 standards of a dental school or an academic medical center with
- 5 which the person is to be affiliated: Provided, That the dental
- 6 school or academic medical center shall be accredited by the
- 7 Commission on Dental Accreditation or the Joint Commission on
- 8 Accreditation of Health Care Organizations;
- 9 (b) A dental teaching permit is valid for one year and may be
- 10 renewed. To renew a dental teaching permit, the applicant shall:
- 11 (1) Submit to the board a written recommendation from the
- 12 dental school dean;
- 13 (2) Successfully complete the West Virginia Dental Law
- 14 Examination;
- 15 (3) Pay the applicable renewal fees;
- 16 (4) Complete the applicable continuing education requirements;
- 17 and
- 18 (5) Have no disciplinary actions taken or pending against him
- 19 or her by any jurisdiction.
- 20 (c) A person who has been issued a dental teaching permit may:
- 21 (1) Teach at a dental school or college offering a doctoral
- 22 degree in dentistry in this state, at a teaching hospital adjacent
- 23 to a dental school or at an academic medical center; and
- 24 (2) Practice dentistry at a dental school or college offering

- 1 a doctoral degree in dentistry in this state, at a teaching
- 2 hospital adjacent to a dental school or at an academic medical
- 3 center.
- 4 (d) While the dental teaching permit is in effect, a permittee 5 is:
- 6 (1) Subject to the restrictions and requirements imposed by 7 this article; and
- 8 (2) Not allowed to receive any fee for service, other than a 9 salary paid by the dental school or academic medical center.
