16	by adding thereto a new section, designated $\$35-5-9$, to read as
17	follows:
18	ARTICLE 5. CEMETERIES.
19	$\S35-5-9$. Names on internments and graves required.
20	From the effective date of this section, every internment or
21	grave shall have a name plate identifying the decedent's identity.
